CONSTRUCTION IMPACT Dixon Grove Junior Middle School

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction on The Westway and surrounding streets, work is scheduled to take place near Dixon Grove Junior Middle School **from Friday, November 28 through the week of December 1, 2025**. During this time, school driveways/parking lot entrances will be impacted during the work at certain times between 7 P.M. -7 A.M., however, access will be maintained during the daytime Monday-Friday.

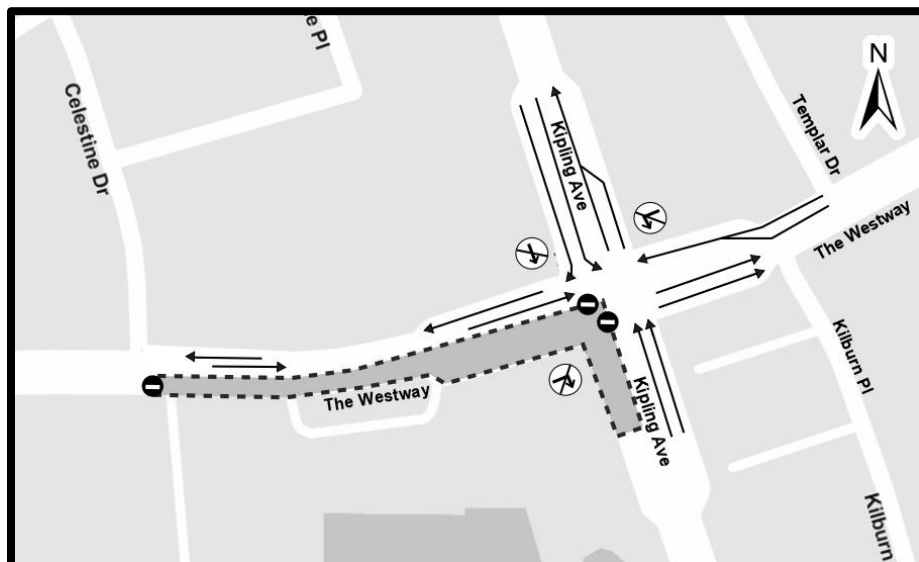
This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.





WORK DETAILS

For this project, the contractor will:

- Excavate on The Westway to install the storm sewer, followed by restoration of the area, and allocate space on Kipling Avenue for material storage during construction.
- This work will require the temporary closure on Kipling Avenue south of The Westway to all traffic.

	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.</p> <p>There will be no impact to pedestrian access to the school, driveways will only be impacted from 7PM to 7AM with full access restored during the day.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however, any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from November 28, 2025 – 7:00PM THROUGH TO December 1, 2025 – 5:00AM, and 7 P.M. to 7 A.M. on the week of December 1, 2025.</p> <p>Regular working hours of 7:00 A.M. – 7:00 P.M., Monday to Friday, will resume following this work.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
