A carefully chosen group of public leaders from across Canada will travel together for a fully hosted visit centered on learning, exchange, and collaboration. You will explore historic sites, witness a dynamic democracy in action, and meet the individuals shaping Israel's complex and compelling story.

This journey comes at a pivotal moment, as the conversation around Israel in Canada continues to evolve. Across campuses, media, unions, and public discourse, nuance is often replaced by polarization. This

delegation offers the opportunity to step into lived realities, engage with diverse voices and return with insight grounded in direct experience.

You'll hear from policymakers, speak with survivors and first responders of the October 7 massacre, visit innovation hubs developing cutting-edge solutions in sectors such as health and emergency preparedness, and explore initiatives focused on social resilience and coexistence. The program includes visits to communities affected by recent conflict and time in cities layered with history and identity.

There will also be space for reflection, connection, and cultural exploration — sharing meals in Haifa, walking through Jerusalem's sacred quarters, visiting Bedouin and Druze communities, and experiencing the energy and complexity of everyday life in Israel.

Ground travel in Israel, accommodations, meals, and program costs are provided by the Consulate of Israel.

Good morning, Councillor,

Here is the breakdown of the per person, on the ground cost for the delegation:

On November 28, **1 ILS was 0.429 CAD.**

Hotels:

5 nights at 1072 ILS per night = 5360 ILS.

In CAD 1072 ILS = \$459.89

For 5 nights, the total for accommodations would be **\$2,299.44**

Note that the hotel costs included breakfast.

Meals:

4 Lunches at 276 ILS per meal = 1104 ILS

In CAD 276 ILS = \$118.40, so total for lunches would be \$473.62

5 Dinners at 381 ILS per meal = 1905 ILS

381 ILS = \$163.45, so total for dinners would be \$817.25

Total for meals would be **\$1290.87**

Meals + Accommodations would therefore total **\$3,590.31**
