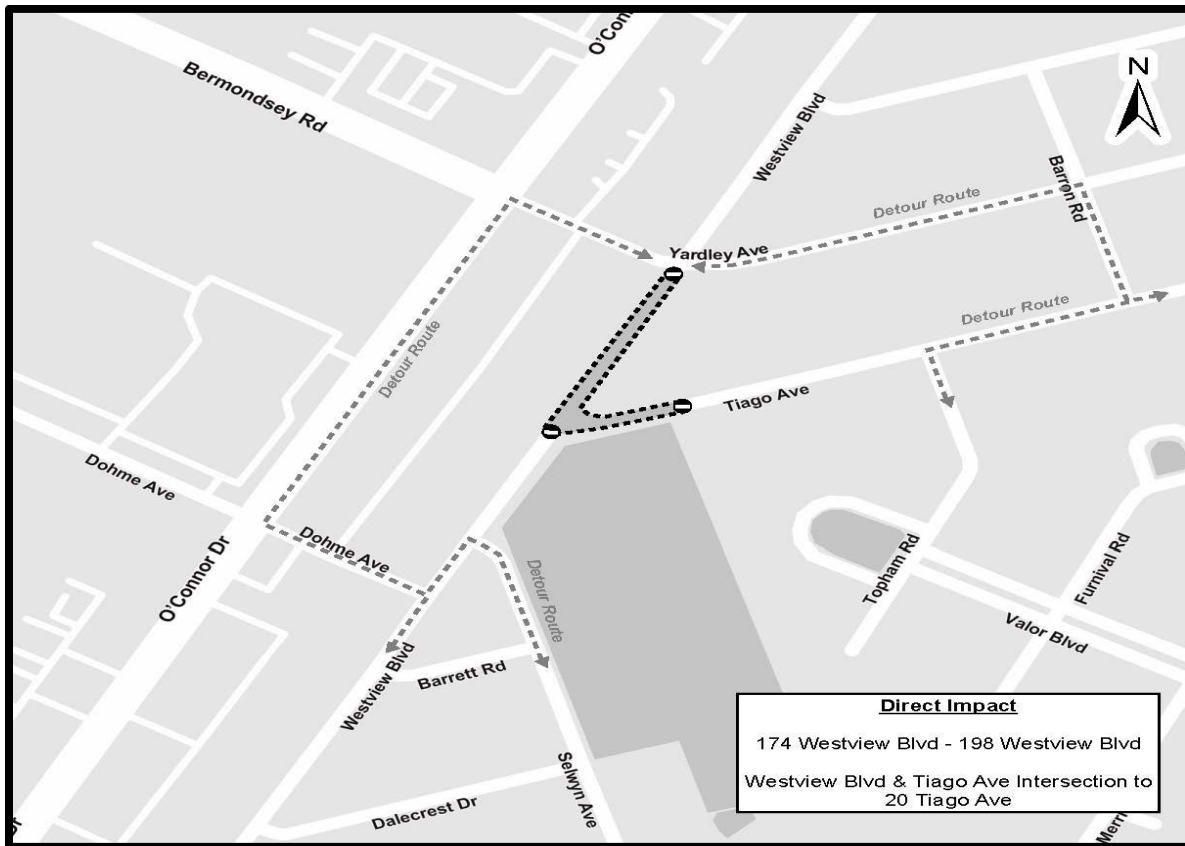
Installation of Storm Sewer on Westview Boulevard and Tiago Avenue

Contract: 23ECS-LU-03FP
Expected Start Date: December 1, 2025
Expected End Date: December 19, 2025
 *Content/dates subject to change

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm sewer system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, a section of Westview Boulevard will be closed. A section of Tiago Avenue will also be closed off at Westview Boulevard.

This closure will be in effect **from 7:00 a.m. on Monday, December 1, 2025, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, December 19, 2025.**

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate the road and dig a trench from 174 - 198 Westview Boulevard to access and install the storm sewer.
- Excavate the road and dig a trench from Westview Boulevard to 20 Tiago Avenue to access and install the storm sewer.
- Full road closure to all through traffic between 174-198 Westview Boulevard.
- Full road closure to all through traffic from Westview Boulevard to 20 Tiago Avenue.
- Residents will have access to the road and use of their driveways except for when construction is occurring in front of their house.
- Driveway Impact Notices will be delivered, as necessary.

	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.</p> <p>Traffic detour plan: Westview Boulevard can be accessed through Topham Road and Barron Road.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work will require temporary sidewalk restrictions. However, pedestrian detour access will always be available during construction.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., from Monday, December 1, 2025, to Friday, December 19, 2025.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
	<p>Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you always park in a legal parking spot.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <p>Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include</p>

the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.

Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e., in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).

To reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
