## Road Closure & Overnight Work on Kipling Avenue and The Westway

Contract: 25ECS-LU-03FP

**Start Date: Friday November 28, 2025 – 7:00PM**

**End Date: December 3, 2025 – 7:00AM**

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, there will be several traffic impacts in your area. Please see below for additional details.


- The intersection of The Westway and Kipling Avenue will experience Southbound lane closures **starting 7:00 PM on Friday, November 28, 2025, to 5:00 AM on Monday, December 1, 2025.**
- There will also be lane closures on The Westway and Kipling Avenue **from 7:00 PM on Monday, December 1, to 7:00 AM Wednesday, December 3, 2025.**

The Contractor is permitted to work 24 hours a day, including overnight, to reduce traffic impacts during the week and until the work can be completed, however, a minimum of one lane in each direction, travelling east and west on The Westway, at the intersection, will always be maintained.

When this overnight work is complete, regular daytime work hours of 7:00 AM TO 7:00 PM will resume. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this disruption.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Program to upgrade the storm and sanitary system in your area and reduce surface and basement flooding.

## WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate at the intersection of The Westway and Kipling Avenue, to install the storm sewer and restore the area.
- Traffic on The Westway will be maintained via one single lane in both directions. For traffic heading southbound on Kipling Avenue from The Westway, please take detour **through Sunvale Drive via Brampton Road**.
- Traffic on Kipling Avenue, north of The Westway, will be maintained in both directions. There will be no through access to Kipling Avenue, south of The Westway. Please take detour to Islington Avenue via The Westway for southbound travel.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Along the **Sunvale Drive and Brampton Road** detour route, residents may experience higher traffic volume than usual.
- The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. Your patience is appreciated.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>There will be no through access for traffic heading SOUTHBBOUND on Kipling Avenue, south of The Westway. Please take detour to Islington Avenue via The Westway for southbound travel.</b></li> </ul>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p><b>Cyclists:</b> If travelling on The Westway, please share the traffic lane in the active work zones)</p>
	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from <b>November 28, 2025, 7:00 PM THROUGH TO December 1, 2025, 5:00 AM, and 7:00 PM on Monday, December 1, to 7:00 AM on Wednesday, December 3.</b></p> <p>Regular working hours will resume on Wednesday, December 3, 2025, starting from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
