DECLARATION OF MAJOR SNOW STORM CONDITION

I, Ashley Curtis, General Manager, Transportation Services, declare a Major Snow Storm Condition for the purposes of City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 950.

Declaration Start Date: January 25, 2026

Time: 4.00pm.

Reasons for Declaration:

The City of Toronto's Weather Service Provider has issued a Winter Severe Storm Report – Winter Severe Weather Outlook for the City of Toronto, Ontario. A significant winter weather event will commence on January 25, 2026, and continue to January 26, 2026, that will result in approximately 28-35cm of snowfall accumulation. This will have the effect of narrowing many streets, especially those with on-street parking, potentially making them impassable to emergency vehicles and impeding important transit lines from efficient and safe operations. The snow is required to be cleared from the roadway and removed to allow for proper movement of vehicles. The clearing of snow may be impeded by traffic and parking on City highways.

As a result, in the interest of public safety, Transportation Services will need a 24/7 operation to plow and be able to remove snow effective immediately on January 25 and requires this declaration to use all tools possible to clear passageways as needed. Parking or standing vehicles on certain City highways is prohibited so the City can complete snow plowing and removal operations. Check current restrictions before parking or standing your vehicle.
