Purpose	To obtain authority to enter into a lease agreement with Post Media Network Inc. (the "Tenant") for office space in the Press Gallery at City Hall, 100 Queen Street West, as a member of the press (the "Lease Agreement").		
Property	100 Queen Street West, Toronto (City Hall). Location Map of the property and the sketch of the office space is shown on the sketch labeled "Toronto Sun" in Appendix "B" (the "Premises").		
Actions	1. Authority be granted to enter into the Lease Agreement with the Tenant, substantially on the terms and conditions set in Appendix "A", and including such other amended terms and conditions deemed appropriate by the approving authority herein, and in a form acceptable to the City Solicitor.		
Financial Impact	<p>As approved by City Council through the adoption of Item 2020.GL16.11, the rent for the media tenants of the Press Gallery at City Hall is comprised of the tenant's proportionate share of operating costs and realty taxes payable for the Premises. Accordingly, this lease arrangement will have no net financial impact.</p> <p>The agreed rents for 2019 to 2028 for the Tenants are outlined in Appendix "A". These funds will be directed to the 2026 Operating Budget for Corporate Real Estate Management (CREM) under cost center FA1406. Future year's revenue will be included in CREM's future budget submissions for council consideration.</p> <p>The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this DAF and agrees with the financial implications as identified in the Financial Impact section.</p>		
Comments	<p>At its meeting on October 27, 28, and 30, 2020, City Council adopted Item 2020.GL 16.11, authorizing new lease agreements with the media tenants of the Press Gallery at City Hall for a term of five (5) years, commencing January 1, 2019 and ending on December 31, 2023, with an option to extend for an additional term of five (5) years. The Tenant has occupied the Premises since January 1, 2019 and continues to occupy the Premises. The Tenant is desirous of executing a lease with a term of five (5) years while also exercising the option to extend.</p> <p>The rent and other major terms and conditions of the Lease Agreement are considered to be fair, reasonable and reflective of the terms authorized by City Council under Item 2020.GL 16.11.</p>

Term: The original term was for a period of five (5) years, commencing on January 1, 2019 and expiring on December 31, 2023. The Tenant has agreed to exercise the option to extend the term for an additional five (5) years to commence on January 1, 2024 and expire on December 31, 2028.

Insurance:

The Tenant shall, at its sole cost and expense, take out and maintain in full force and effect, at all times throughout the Term, the following insurance:

- (a) "All Risks" insurance on property of every description and kind owned by the Tenant, or for which the Tenant is legally liable, or which is installed by or on behalf of the Tenant within the Premises or on the Property or Building, including, without limitation, stock-in-trade, furniture, equipment, partitions, trade fixtures and leasehold improvements, in an amount not less than the full replacement cost thereof from time to time
- (b) General liability and property damage insurance, including personal liability, contractual liability, tenants' legal liability, non-owned automobile liability and owners' and contractors' protective insurance coverage, with respect to the Premises and the Common Areas, which coverage shall include the business operations conducted by the Tenant and any other person on the Premises. Such policies shall be written on a comprehensive basis with coverage for any one occurrence or claim of not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) or such higher limits as the Landlord may reasonably require from time to time
