Gardiner Expressway Strategic Rehabilitation: Section 3 Early Works on Five Bridges

### **Overnight Lane Reductions and Ramp Closures - Park Lawn Road**

As part of ongoing Gardiner Expressway bridge rehabilitation work, the following overnight lane restrictions and ramp closures will be required as crews complete preparatory work in advance of work on the east and west abutment of the Park Lawn Road bridge.

- **Thursday, February 19 - Friday, February 20:**
  - Two lanes will be closed at eastbound Gardiner between Grand Avenue and Park Lawn Road - two lanes will remain open.
  - The transfer between the collector and express lanes on the eastbound Gardiner will be fully closed.
  - One lane in each direction will be closed on Park Lawn Road.
  - One left-turn lane on the Park Lawn eastbound off-ramp will be closed (one left-turn lane will remain open).
  - The northbound left-turn lane from Park Lawn Road at the Park Lawn eastbound off-ramp intersection will be closed.
  - Paid duty officers will be stationed at the signalized intersections on Park Lawn.
  
- **Friday, February 20 - Saturday, February 21:**
  - Two eastbound Gardiner lanes between Grand Avenue and Park Lawn Road will be closed - two lanes will remain open.
  - The eastbound Lakeshore off-ramp will be closed.
  - The transfer between the collector and express lanes on the eastbound Gardiner will be fully closed.

### **Long-Term Lane Restrictions on Park Lawn Road**

Following preparatory work, longer term lane restrictions will be implemented to complete abutment work on the Park Lawn Road Bridge.

Phase 1 (mid-Feb - mid-March)\*

- One southbound lane on Park Lawn Road will be closed.

Phase 2 (mid-March - April 30)\*

- One northbound lane on Park Lawn Road will be closed.
