Work in Progress and What to Expect between February 20 and March 6, 2026

Building Construction

Two cranes continue to install the wood building panels and crews are installing electrical, heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems inside the building as it is built.

Neighbours can expect noise from carpentry to install the building panels. The level of vibration is expected to be low.

Wall panel delivery and building construction is expected to take place through to March 9, 2026.

Each delivery involves:

- A truck entering the site
- Offloading materials
- Reversing out with the support of a traffic flagger
- Backup safety beepers when trucks reverse

Frequency: About **one delivery per day**, five days a week

Truck size: 40 to 53 feet in length

Working Hours

Construction working hours for February are as follows:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Saturday: 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

New: Sunday 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Depending on the weather forecast, crews may need to complete snow removal activities, including use of a snowblower and / or a small skid steer ("Bobcat").
