
**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL ELECTRONIC HEARING:

- 1. Vinod Randy Kangal** (Report No. 8019)
o/a Randy's Curb Side
Applicant for Renewal of Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence No. V15-5022490; Plate 01606
AND
Vinod Randy Kangal
o/a Randy's Roti & Double's
Applicant for an Eating or Drinking Establishment Licence (Application No. C590994)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on March 11, 2026 (by Municipal Licensing and Standards) and March 12, 2026 (by Vinod Randy Kangal), as follows:

"The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence will be renewed and the Eating or Drinking Establishment Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All overdue by-law fines that have been incurred by Vinod Randy Kangal in relation to the charges or convictions listed at pages 15-18 of Report No. 8019 (dated October 2, 2025) must be paid within 6 months of this signed Proposed Resolution;
- (2) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence may be cancelled and the Eating or Drinking Establishment Licence application may be denied;
- (3) Immediately upon the Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence being renewed and the Eating or Drinking Establishment Licence being issued, both the Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence and the Eating or Drinking Establishment Licence will be placed on probation for a period of One (1) year. Vinod Randy Kangal is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Vinod Randy Kangal and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to

ensure Vinod Randy Kangal is in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws; and

- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Vinod Randy Kangal or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 8019 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”

2. Mohammad Yasin (Report No. 8069)

Holder of Toronto Taxicab Owner’s Licence No. V02-3101764; Taxicab Plate No. A0101

DECISION:

The Tribunal ordered Mohammad Yasin’s Toronto Taxicab Owner’s Licence No. V02-3101764; shall be immediately suspended on the following conditions:

- (1) Mohammad Yasin is to register a new vehicle with Municipal Licensing and Standards that complies with the conditions of Chapter 546-51 of the Toronto Municipal Code;
- (2) Mohammad Yasin is to return Taxicab Plate No. A0101 to the Municipal Licensing and Standards office at 850 Coxwell Avenue, Toronto, Ontario, M4C 5R1;
- (3) The temporary suspension of Toronto Taxicab Owner’s Licence No. V02-3101764 will be lifted after one of the two above conditions are satisfied.

The Tribunal proceeded with a hearing on this matter ex parte, at the request of Municipal Licensing and Standards. The Tribunal is satisfied that Mohammad Yasin was properly served notice of today’s hearing.
