


The City of Toronto is carrying out soffit repairs to the F.G. Gardiner Expressway bridge from Grand Magazine Street to York Street and from Cherry Street to the Don Valley Parkway. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future.

### WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Repair the existing F.G. Gardiner Expressway structure between Grand Magazine Street and York Street, and from Cherry Street to the Don Valley Parkway
- Install temporary soffit shoring systems to support the underside of the elevated expressway
- Perform all work in a manner that extends the service life of the structure until long-term rehabilitation or replacement is completed

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.</p> <p>Overhead work at Lake Shore Boulevard will be completed at night from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday to Friday.</p> <p>Additional after hours and weekend work may also be required.</p>
	<p><b>Pre-Construction Inspection:</b> The City hired contractor Grascan Construction LTD / Torbridge Construction LTD under contract to the City of Toronto, is conducting inspections of properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Affected properties will receive a separate notice to set up an appointment for the inspection.</p> <p>The inspection will look at the exterior and interior of properties to verify existing conditions. Although participation is voluntary, the City encourages all property owners to participate. Without the survey, it will be difficult to confirm any claims of damage caused by construction. All inspection staff will wear photo I.D. and carry photo equipment for this work.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Pedestrian access will be maintained wherever possible. Temporary sidewalk closures may be required at times, with clearly signed detours provided to safely guide pedestrians around the work area.</b></p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p><b>Traffic on the Lake Shore Blvd. may be reduced to one lane in the work zone during overnight construction periods.</b></p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
