This notice provides an update on the ongoing watermain replacement on Sorauren Avenue. Crews are currently working on water service connections at the intersections where connections to the new watermain are not complete. Intersecting roads such Wright Avenue and Wabash Avenue will be areas of ongoing construction activity.

Once water service connections are completed, crews will be shutting down construction activities and demobilizing from the site on **December 19, 2025**. All construction equipment and materials will be removed from the street during the winter months.

Construction will resume in the spring of 2026. Once start dates are confirmed another construction update will be circulated prior to work resuming. Please refer to the construction timeline below for planned construction dates in 2026 .

- Watermain mainline has been installed from Queen Street W to Dundas Street W.
- Water service connections have been completd from Queen Street W to Wright Avenue .
- Watermain connections have been completed from Quenn Street W to Wright Avenue.
- All watremain and water service work has been completed on Virtue .

UPCOMING WORK IN 2026


- Water service replacement from Wright Street to Dundas Street
- Watermain connection from Wright Street to Dundas Street W
- Sidewalk replacement from Queen Street w to Dundas Street W
- Sidewalk replacement on Virture Street
- Road resurfacing from Queen Street W to Dundas Street W
- Installation of pavement markings

Traffic/Parking during Winter Break

- During the winter break Sorauren Avenue will be reopened to all on street parking.
- Road traffic on Souraren Avenue will return to normal once crews demobilize and complete

temporary restorations in all areas before the winter break.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During construction traffic on Sorauren Avenue will be reduced to one lane with traffic personnel.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>People Cycling: Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>

	Additional information regarding on street parking during construction will be provided in the next construction update
	<p>Parking Violation Notice: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
