
## Black Creek Drive Over Black Creek Bridge Rehabilitation

**Contract: 25ECS-BE-04PM**  
**Start Date: April 2025 End Date: March 2026**  
**NEW End Date: June 2026**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

This notice provides an update on the rehabilitation of the Bridge at Black Creek Drive Over Black Creek. Work on this project is currently behind schedule due to the relocation of electrical components and recent weather conditions. The City's contractor continues to work diligently to complete the remainder of the project.

We acknowledge that this project has impacted motorists using this route, for which we apologize. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to enhance the safety of our infrastructure for travel.

### WORK STATUS TO DATE

The following work completed:

- Reconstruction of the parapet walls, railings and approach slabs.
- Reconstruction of bearing seats and replacement of the bearings (stage 1).
- Strengthen the girders' ends and concrete of the concrete deck top and soffit (stage 1).
- Replaced the asphalt surface and waterproofing, and paving of roadway shoulders (stage 1).

### REMAINING WORK

- Reconstruction of median barrier wall.
- Resurfacing of the deck and approach roadway for stage 2 (the middle section).
- Reconstruction of remaining bearing seats and replacement of bearings for stage 2.
- Strengthen the girders' ends and patch repair the concrete deck for stage 2.
- Replace the asphalt surface and waterproofing for stage 2.
- Remove temporary electrical poles and cables.
- Install durable line painting.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The city will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturdays. No work will occur on Sundays and Statutory holidays <b>unless approved.</b></p>
	<p><b>Pre-Construction Inspection:</b> The City hired contractor will conduct inspections of properties within 30 metres of the construction area before construction starts. Affected properties will receive a separate notice to set up an appointment for the inspection.</p> <p>The inspection will look at the exterior and interior of properties to verify existing conditions. Although participation is voluntary, the City encourages all property owners to participate. Without the survey, it will be difficult to confirm any claims of damage caused by construction. All inspection staff will wear photo I.D. and carry photo equipment for this work.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Sidewalks on the bridge will be removed during construction and will not be replaced.</b></p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b></p> <p>Traffic staging will be implemented and the traffic lanes will be reduced throughout the construction. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side street. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p><b>Temporary concrete barriers and pylons will be placed on Black Creek Drive, with single-lane reductions in each direction.</b></p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
	<p><b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).</p>
