## Sanitary and Storm Sewer Replacement, Watermain Replacement, and Road Resurfacing on Danforth Avenue from Main Street to Victoria Park Avenue

**Start Date: March 20, 2026 | End Date: March 21, 2026**

The City of Toronto's work on Danforth Avenue from Main Street to Victoria Park Avenue is progressing well and is anticipated to be completed on time. This notice is to provide an update on upcoming overnight watermain replacement work that will take place on Danforth Avenue between Main Street and Dawes Avenue.

The contractor will conduct the above-mentioned overnight activities from **11:00 p.m. on Friday, March 20 to 3:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 21, 2026**. The Contractor is permitted to work overnight to reduce the impacts to traffic on Danforth Avenue during the day and to minimize the impact of water service disruptions. When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume.

Construction work will resume during the day on **Monday, March 23, 2026**.

Thank you for your patience and understanding during this overnight work.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> To complete the work safely, there will be road, sidewalk, and bikeway restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p><b>Danforth Avenue will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction.</b></p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
