

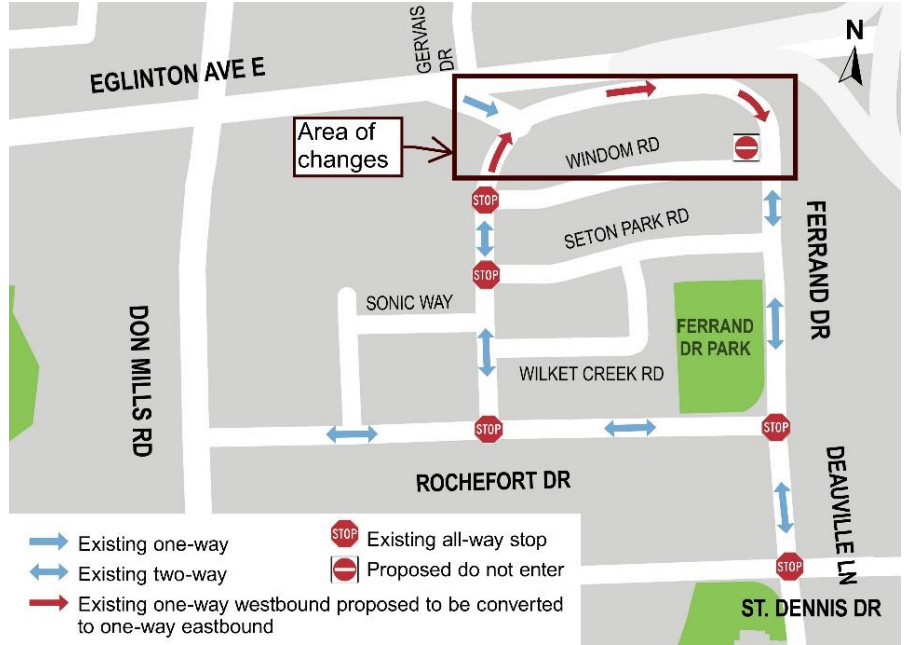

## Street direction changes on Ferrand Drive, north of Windom Road

The City of Toronto is proposing to change the direction of motor vehicle traffic on Ferrand Drive, north of Windom Road, from one-way westbound to one-way eastbound. There are no changes proposed to the number of vehicle lanes. **Learn more about this change and provide feedback by May 5, 2026.**

### Why Consider Changes on Ferrand Drive?

In July 2024, the City installed cycle tracks on Ferrand Drive and converted two-way motor vehicle traffic to one-way westbound, north of Windom Road. Since installation, the City has monitored the project by: observing operations, conducting new traffic and speed counts, and continuing to collect, record and respond to public and interest group feedback.

This change is proposed to improve the efficiency of waste collection operations, and in response to post-installation monitoring of the changes.

### Proposed Change

- One-way motor vehicle traffic converted from westbound to eastbound direction in the north segment of Ferrand Drive, between Windom Road (east intersection) and Windom Road (west intersection).
- No motor vehicle access northbound at Ferrand Drive at Windom Road (east intersection), "Do Not Enter"

**There are no changes to existing bikeways on Ferrand Drive and no changes south of Windom Road.** City services such as Fire, Paramedics and garbage pick-up will continue during implementation. The adjustment would be implemented using pavement markings, signage and 'quick-build' materials, which involve short installation times and minimal disruption to traffic.

**The City is inviting residents to learn more about this change and provide feedback by May 5, 2026.**
