## CONSTRUCTION IMPACT Royalcrest Road (over Albion Creek) Culvert Replacement

**Contract: 26ECS-BE-06PM**

**Expected Start Date: July 2026**

**Expected End Date: December 2026**

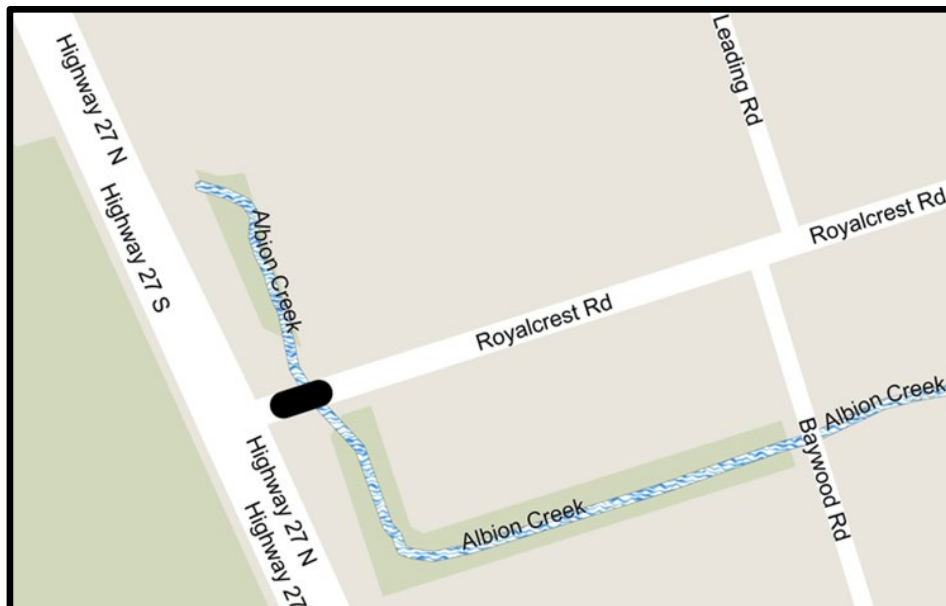
The City of Toronto is replacing the Royalcrest Road (over Albion Road) Culvert. Construction is expected to take place from July 2026 to December 2026. The existing culvert is nearing the end of its service life showing deteriorations and is hydraulically deficient, therefore needs to be replaced.

### WORK DETAILS

The project will include installing and removing the temporary creek flow bypass system, installing and removing temporary shoring, excavating and removing excess soil, removing and disposing the existing culvert, installing a new reinforced concrete culvert and retaining wall, and restoring the roadway and site.

**To complete this work safely and efficiently, a road closure at the Highway 27 and Royalcrest Road intersection is being planned for the duration of the construction.** Pedestrian traffic and the entrances for businesses on Royalcrest Road will continue to be maintained. The Highway 27 and Mars Road intersection will be temporarily signalized, with additional stop signs through the area.
