CONSTRUCTION IMPACT Rolling Road Closure Nugent Road

Contract: 25ECS-LU-03FP

Start Date: April 17, 2026

End Date: May 31, 2026

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. **This is to notify you that storm box culvert installation work will commence shortly. The installation involves a rolling road closure, moving along Nugent Road from Wincott Drive to Kipling Avenue as the work advances. The rolling road closure is scheduled to take place on Nugent Road from 7:00 A.M. on April 17, 2026, to 7:00 P.M. on May 31, 2026.**

Driveway Access Impact notices will be delivered separately to residents 48 hrs in advance with exact impact dates.

Impacts to Residents:

- Temporary rolling road closure of Nugent Road to all traffic with limited local traffic access
- Heavy machinery, large box culvert structures, and construction vehicles. Expect significant congestion on the street and traffic delays.
- Emergency access will be maintained

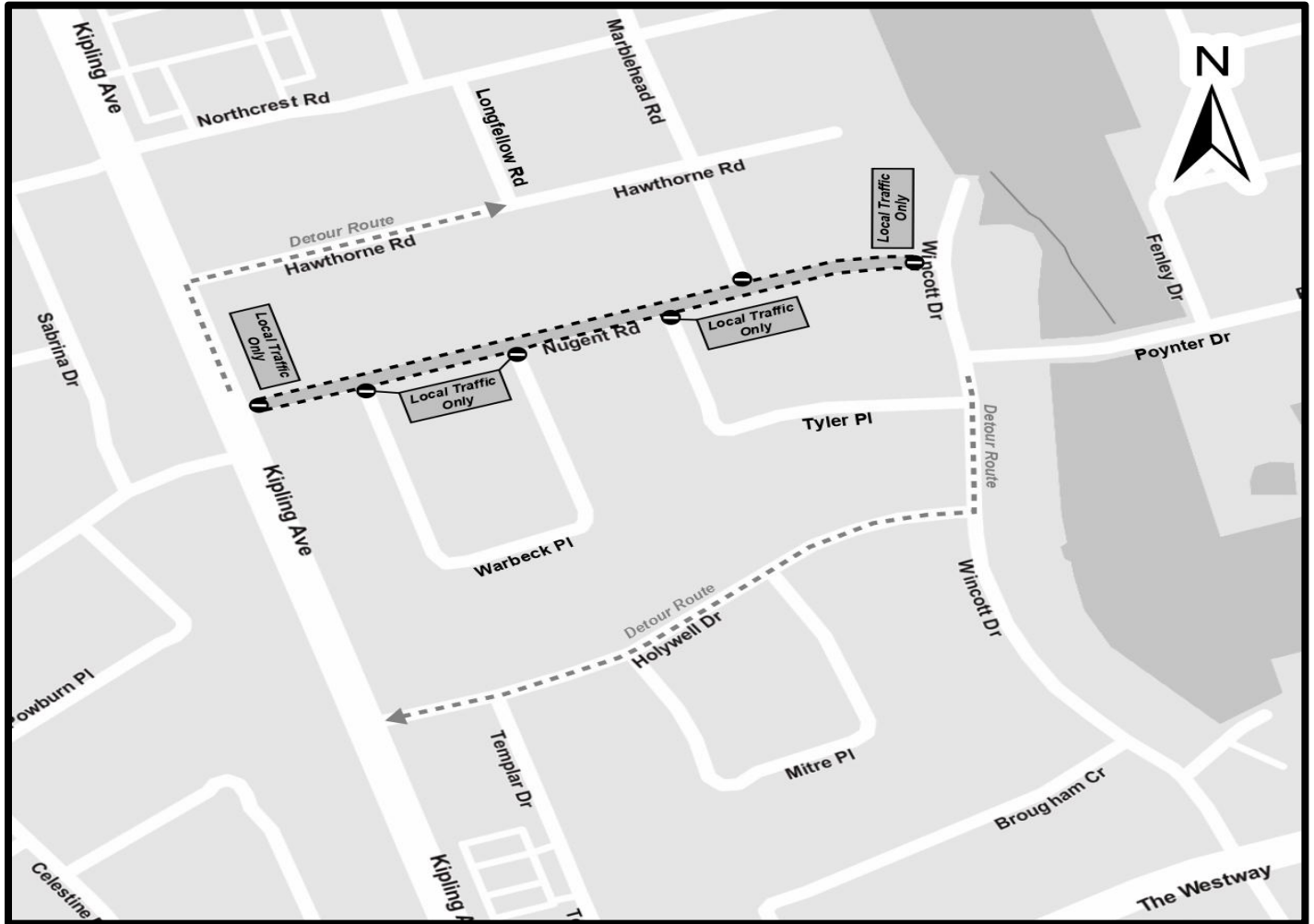
This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

The Contractor will:




- Excavate on Nugent Road to install the storm box culvert sewer.
- Allocate space on Nugent Road, and Wincott Drive, for material storage during construction, followed by restoration of the area at a later date.
- Close Nugent Road during the day and restore one lane for access in the evenings wherever possible.
- Notify residents ahead of any temporary **short-term** disruption to services.
- Assist residents with **navigating the site** during the workday, **home deliveries**, and **garbage collection** as needed. **Consider adding your house number to your bins.**

Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.

Driveway Access: This work will require temporary closure of driveways on Nugent Road. Should your home be impacted, you will receive a driveway access notice in advance. This notice will detail the closure timeline and location of alternate street parking.

	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however, any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place during the weekday from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
