CONSTRUCTION IMPACT **Jardine Place / Celestine Drive**

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm and sanitary system in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. **This is to notify you that storm box culvert installation work is scheduled to commence shortly. The installation involves a rolling road closure, moving along Jardine Place in a north to south direction as the work advances.** The rolling road closure is scheduled to take place on Jardine Place from **7:00 A.M. on April 13, 2026, to 7:00 P.M. on April 30, 2026.**

Impact to Celestine Drive:

- Access to Jardine Place will be closed to all traffic
- Heavy machinery, large box culvert structures, and construction vehicles will be present on Celestine Drive and Jardine Place.
- Traffic should expect delays when navigating this portion of Celestine Drive and is encouraged to use alternate routes.

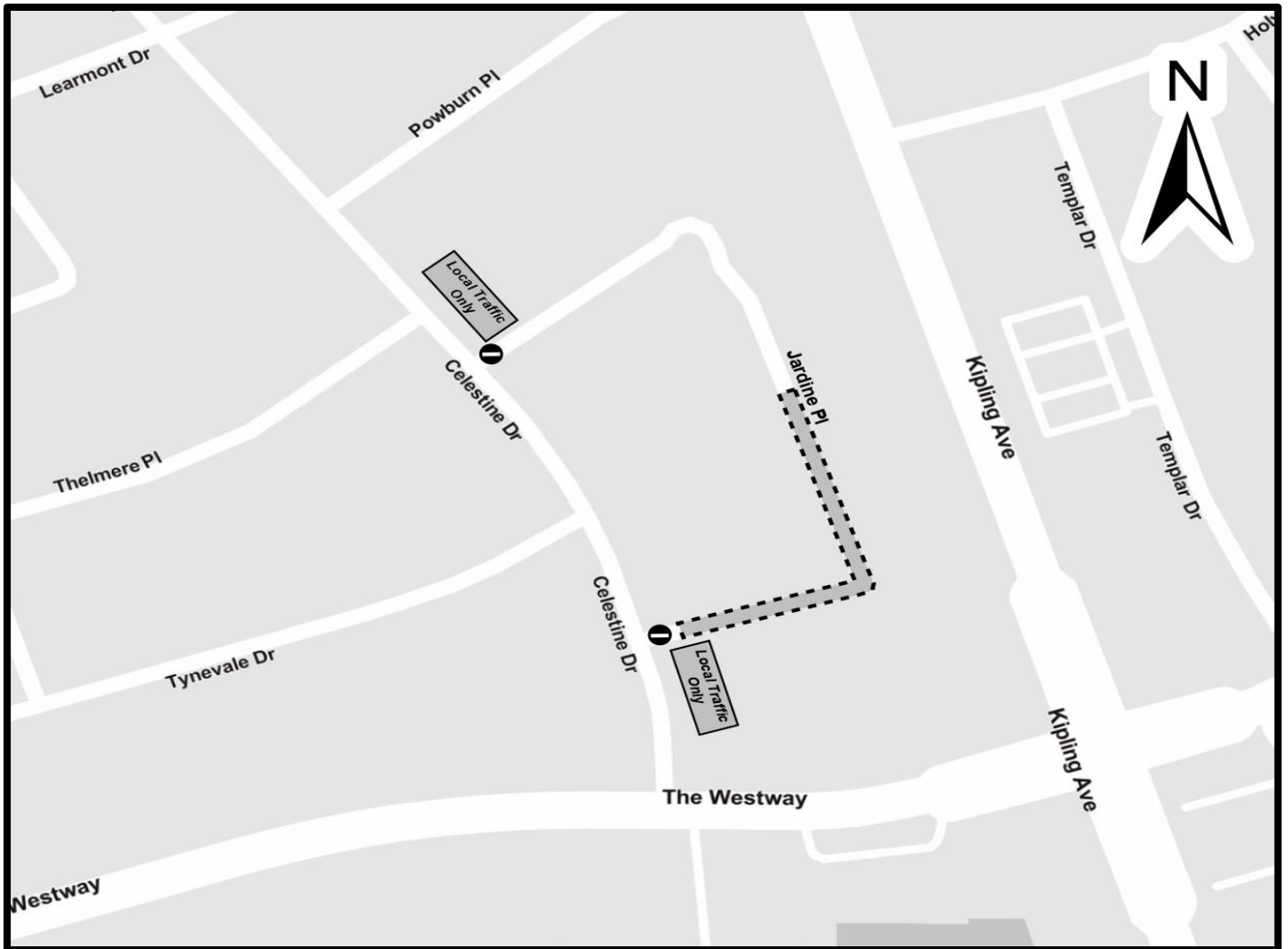
This project is part of the Council-approved 2025 Basement Flooding Protection Program to improve the water distribution system, renew our aging infrastructure and reduce the risk of sewer collapse or blockages that cause sewer backups and flooding.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate on Jardine Place to install the storm box culvert sewer
- Allocate space on Jardine Place for material storage during construction, followed by restoration of the area at a later date.
- Emergency access will be maintained
- Sidewalk access will be maintained.
- Flag persons will be present on the north and south end of Jardine Place, at Celestine Drive, to assist with navigation.

Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.

Traffic Detour:

Access on Celestine Drive will be maintained; however, it is recommended that any traffic travelling north or south on Celestine Drive plan an alternate route to avoid delays.

	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however, any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place during the weekday from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
