Upcoming Overnight Lane Reductions and Ramp Closures - April 7 - 10, 2026

As part of preparatory work for future Gardiner Expressway Rehabilitation Section 3 work, the following overnight lane restrictions and ramp closures will be in effect. While this work is not part of the current construction activities, it will occur in the vicinity.

All work will take place overnight between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. when traffic volumes are lower to help ensure the safety of crews and the travelling public.

- **Monday, April 6 to Tuesday, April 7:**
 - **Eastbound Gardiner will be reduced to:**
 - Three lanes from Highway 427 to the Highway 427 on-ramp
 - Four lanes from Highway 427 on-ramp to Wickman Road

- **Tuesday, April 7 to Wednesday, April 8:**
 - **Eastbound Gardiner will be reduced to:**
 - Four lanes from Highway 427 on-ramp to Kipling Avenue off-ramp
 - Two lanes from Kipling Avenue off-ramp to Royal York

- **Wednesday, April 8 to Thursday, April 9:**
 - **Eastbound Gardiner will be reduced to**
 - Two lanes from the Kipling Avenue on-ramp to the Horner Avenue off-ramp
 - Two lanes from the Islington Avenue on-ramp to the Islington Avenue off-ramp
 - Lake Shore Boulevard on-ramp will be reduced to one lane
 - **Westbound Gardiner will be reduced to:**
 - Two lanes from Islington Avenue to Kipling Avenue
 - Three lanes from Park Lawn Road to Kipling Avenue
 - Two lanes from Windermere Avenue to the Lake Shore Boulevard West on-ramp
 - Three lanes from the Lake Shore Boulevard West on-ramp to Park Lawn Avenue
 - **The following ramps will be closed**
 - South-to-Eastbound Kipling Avenue on-ramp
 - Eastbound-to-South Horner Avenue off-ramp
 - South-to-Eastbound Islington Avenue on-ramp
 - Eastbound-to-North Islington Avenue off-ramp

- **Thursday, April 9 to Friday, April 10:**
 - **Eastbound Gardiner will be reduced to:**

- Two lanes from Horner Avenue on-ramp to the Islington Avenue off-ramp
- **Westbound Gardiner will be reduced to:**
 - One lane from the St. Lawrence Avenue off-ramp to the Expressway to Collector crossover
 - Two lanes from the Expressway to Collector crossover to Kipling Avenue
 - Four lanes from the Kipling Avenue on-ramp to the East Mall off-ramp towards Highway 427
 - Two lanes from the Expressway to Collector crossover to Kipling Avenue
- The westbound left shoulder lane will be closed from Islington Avenue to Kipling Avenue
- The westbound left shoulder lane will be closed over the East Mall
- **The following ramps will be closed**
 - North-to-Eastbound Horner Avenue on-ramp
 - Eastbound-to-South Islington Avenue off-ramp
