DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution signed on April 2, 2026, as follows:

“The Public Garage Licence will immediately subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Alexander Cherniak shall not attend the public garage located at 321 Rexdale Boulevard, Unit 4 at any time for any reason;
- (2) Alexander Cherniak shall, immediately upon the disposition of the charge laid against him on April 28, 2025 under the Criminal Code, report the outcome of the proceedings, including any sentence or conditions to which he may be subject, to Municipal Licensing and Standards by e-mail to mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca;
- (3) At any time, either of the Parties may request that this matter be brought back before the Toronto Licensing Tribunal as soon as reasonably possible for a further hearing, at which time the Tribunal may issue, suspend, or revoke the licence or vary these conditions.”
