Road Resurfacing, Watermain Replacement and Sidewalk Replacement on Sorauren Avenue from Dundas Street W to Queen Street W and Virtue Street from Sorauren Avenue to East End Limit

Contract: 25ECS-RD-05RR
RESTART DATE: April 13, 2026 | END DATE: July 2026

This notice provides an update on the ongoing watermain replacement on Sorauren Avenue. Construction crews will restart work on Sourareuen Avenue on **Monday April 13**. Crews will start work at the south end of Sorauren Avenue and will be working north towards Dundas Street W.

Construction crews are scheduled to carry out water service connections on the north half of Sorauren Avenue (from Wright Avenue to Dundas Street West) while simultaneously replacing the sidewalk and repairing the road base on the southern section (from Queen Street West to Pearson Avenue). Crews on both sides will progress northward, continuing this approach until all underground and surface works are completed.

During construction, daily traffic and local access for residents will be maintained in one active lane however, when road resurfacing is scheduled there will be **NO on street parking on Souraruen Avenue** during construction. As work progresses our contractor will reopen sections of the road once completed.

Residents on **Virtue Street** will receive separate notification with additional construction information and what to expect during the early weeks of construction. Below is a construction schedule for work from April to July 2026. Please refer to the construction timeline below for planned construction dates in 2026.

Further construction updates will be circulated informing residents of construction progress and what upcoming road restrictions to expect.

COMPLETED WORK IN 2025

- Watermain mainline has been installed from Queen Street W to Dundas Street W.
- Water service connections have been completd from Queen Street W to Wright Avenue .
- Watermain connections have been completed from Quenn Street W to Wright Avenue.

- All watremain and water service work has been completed on Virtue Street.

UPCOMING WORK IN 2026

- Water service replacement from Wright Street to Dundas Street
- Watermain connection from Wright Street to Dundas Street W
- Sidewalk/Crubb/interlock replacement, road base repair, and resurfacing from Queen Street w to Dundas Street W
- Sidewalk/Crubb/interlock replacement, road base repair, and resurfacing at Virtu St
- Installation of pavement markings









LOCAL TRAFFIC & PARKING RESTRICTIONS DURING CONSTRUCTION

- On Monday April 13, construction crews will begin to mobilize on Soruraren Avenue and surrounding areas. Residents can expect traffic barrels, construction materials and various heavy equipment to be stored within the work area. During sidewalk replacements there will always be one side of the street open for pedestrian sidewalk use.
- For most of the construction schedule there will be no on street parking on Sorauren Avenue. Residents with on street parking permits are permitted to park anywhere within Zone 2.
- Cars still parked on Sorauren Avenue on Monday April 13, will receive a friendly tow to a location in the area. Addiitonal contact information can be found under the parkig section in the table below.
- Additional paid duty police officers and traffic personelle will be on site to direct traffic during construction. Due to the location of water service connections there will be times when road/intersection access will be disrupted due to construction activities. During these times, we ask that residents be patient while traffic personelle communicate with construction crews to provide access.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During construction traffic on Sorauren Avenue will be reduced to one lane with traffic personnel. • Drivers are advised to use alternative travel routes through the area and should expect delays if they travel on Sorauren Avenue during construction.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>People Cycling: Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location. Additional information regarding on street parking during construction will be provided in the next construction update</p>
	<p>Parking Violation Notice: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon</p>

	as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
