







## WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Upgrade house services within the city boulevard, i.e., water main, sanitary sewer, and potential storm sewer.
- Restore concrete curbs and sidewalks.
- House numbers **7 through 31 Amsterdam Avenue** will be directly impacted by construction.
- During temporary and final restoration operations, the road will be closed to traffic.
- The road will be closed and local traffic only allowed within the work zone between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. daily.
- When driveway access is not available, please park in a legal spot on a local side street and display the Driveway Impact Notice in your windshield.

	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.</p> <p><b>Detour Plan:</b> Northbound and southbound traffic on Westview Boulevard shall be routed via Holland Avenue, Glenburn Avenue, and Galbraith Avenue.</p>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> Pedestrian access on Westview Boulevard will be restricted. However, one side of the walkway will be accessible during this time.</p>
	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>



**Parking Violation Notices:** Please ensure you always park in a legal parking spot. If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:

1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) **or**
2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.

If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.

**Please note:** Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e., in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).

To reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
