## Timberbank Boulevard Culvert Replacement over West Highland Creek

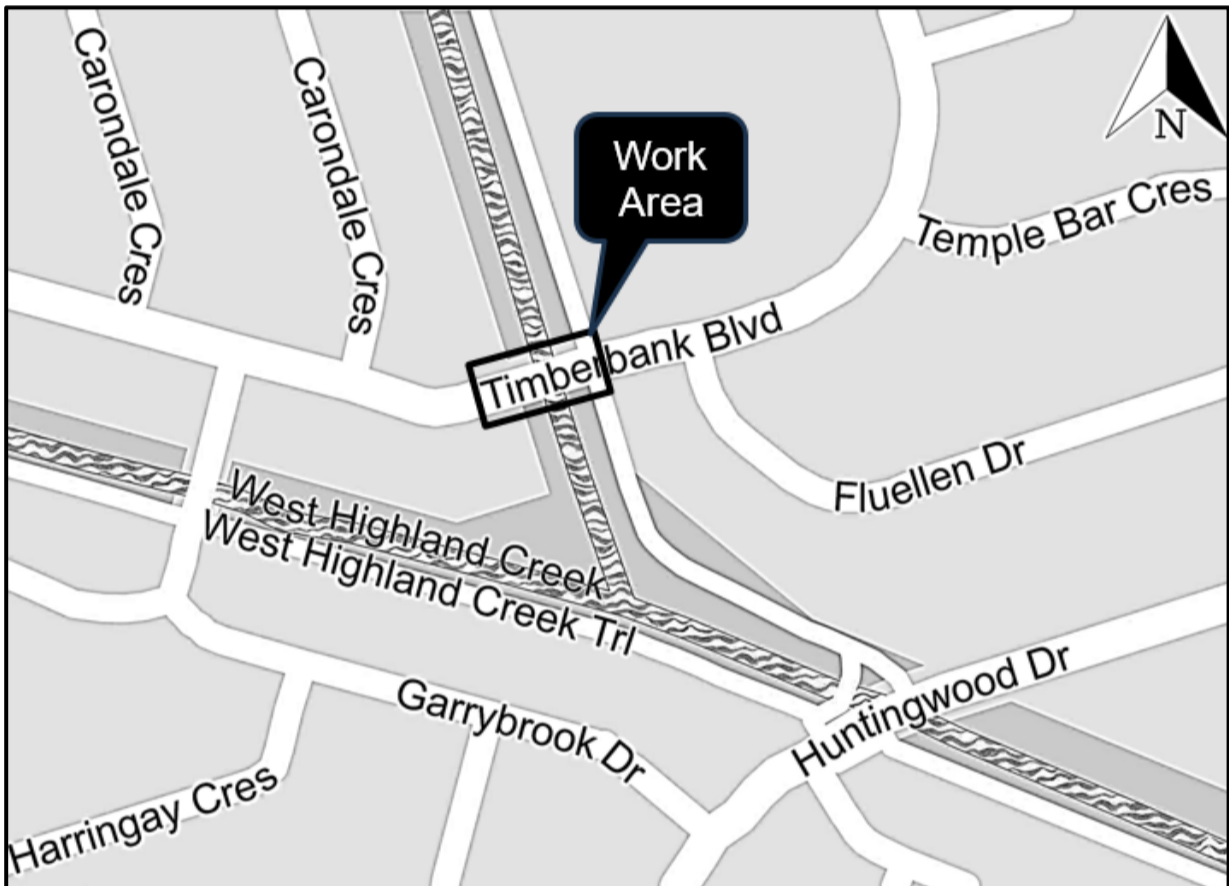
**Contract: 26ECS-BE-07PM**

The City of Toronto is planning to replace the Timberbank Boulevard Culvert over West Highland Creek. This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2026 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p><b>Access to Your Home:</b> The City-hired contractor may need access to the interior and exterior of your home to complete a pre-construction condition survey. Affected properties will receive a letter about scheduling a time to complete the pre-construction condition survey. Although participation is voluntary, the pre-construction survey results may be useful to confirm claims for potential damage caused by City construction.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone.</p> <p><b>Timberbank Boulevard will be closed to traffic for the duration of construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with one sidewalk opened at all times. Pedestrians will be required to cross the road at the nearest crosswalk to access the opened sidewalk during construction.</b></p>



**Accessible Accommodation:** The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Field Ambassador** listed below.
