
**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL ELECTRONIC HEARING:
May 14, 2026 (1:00 PM)
Summary of Decisions

- 1. Ghulam Hassan Faroqiyar** (Report No. 8086)
Applicant for the Renewal of Toronto Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V00-4427132; Taxicab Plate No. 04251
Applicant of a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. C569022)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment to June 25, 2026 at 1:00 p.m., to be scheduled for an in-person hearing, on consent.

Tyrone Crawford, Solicitor for Ghulam Hassan Faroqiyar requested an adjournment of this matter in order for a Farsi interpreter to appear in-person to assist with the hearing. Municipal Licensing and Standards agreed to the adjournment request.

- 2. Shomuj Ali** (Report No. 8029)
Holder of Taxicab Owner Licence No. V02-5141741

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution signed on May 14, 2026, as follows:

"The Taxicab Owner Licence will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All overdue by-law fines that have been incurred by Shomuj Ali in relation to the charges or convictions listed at page 7-8 of Report No. 8029 must be paid within 60 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;

- (2) All application fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the Licence may be cancelled;
- (3) Immediately upon the licence being renewed the Taxicab Owner Licence will be placed on probation for a period of **Three (3)** years. Shomuj Ali is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Shomuj Ali and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Shomuj Ali's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) Prior to the next **Three (3)** renewals of the licence, Shomuj Ali must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at their own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of their Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Shomuj Ali or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 8029 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
