Rosehill Pumping Station Noise Attenuation Panel Installation

The City of Toronto will begin the installation of noise attenuation panels (sound barrier walls) to reduce the noise caused by the external radiator/cooling fans at the two standby generators on the Rosehill Pumping Station rooftop, located at **240 Mount Pleasant Road** near St Clair Avenue East and Mount Pleasant Road. Noise wall panels are being installed to mitigate disruptions from the operation of the emergency power generators during summer months. Rosehill Pumping Station supplies clean drinking water to the community and is essential to the water infrastructure of the local neighbourhood.

The work will take place within the grounds of the Pumping Station, primarily on the rooftop. During construction, cranes and other construction equipment will be used for noise wall panel installation. To facilitate these works, one lane of traffic on the southbound side of Mount Pleasant Road will be temporarily closed. Closures will be minimized to a few hours during off-peak traffic hours to reduce traffic impacts in this area. Upon completion of construction, the laydown area will be permanently restored.

WORK DETAILS

For installation works, the Contractor will:

- Perform preparation work on and around the roof top of the pumping station for installation of a mechanical frame for noise panel mounting.
- Place the noise panels on the frame.
- Perform restoration works to reinstate the laydown areas to its original state.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property, please ensure that you remove/arrange for removal of each item prior to construction.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on the southbound lanes of Mount Pleasant Road directly in front of Rosehill Pumping Station. This is a short, one lane closure with minimal disruptions. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p>
	<p>Dust Mitigation: The Contractor will implement effective dust-control measures, including the application of water, brine, or calcium chloride. All public roadways will be maintained in a clean condition and kept free of mud for the duration of construction.</p>
