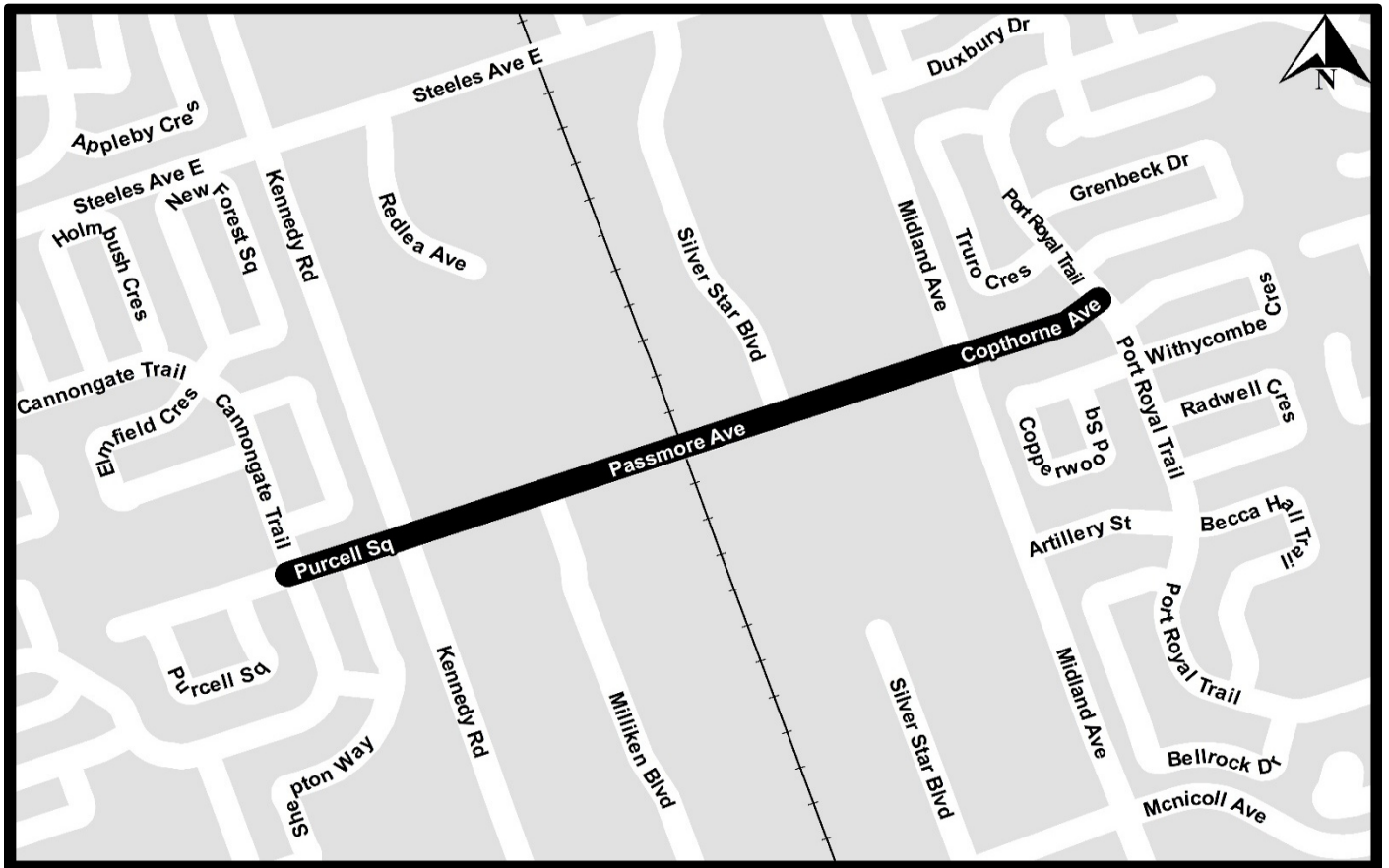

This notice provides an update on the watermain replacement and road resurfacing on Purcell Square. Construction is progressing well, with installation of the new watermain anticipated to be completed by **May 15, 2026**, weather permitting. Once this work is complete, the next stage will involve testing and chlorination of the new watermain to ensure it meets all City and safety standards before being put into service. This is a routine but important step to confirm the system is safe and ready for use. There will be minimal site activities during the watermain testing and chlorination phase of work.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we complete these essential upgrades.

- Complete road resurfacing following completion of underground work

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences.
- The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p>Site Safety: Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the Site Inspector. If the Site Inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.</p>
	<p>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>Telephone and Internet Services: This work may affect phone and internet cables for individual properties that aren't buried deep below the sidewalk. The contractor will coordinate with utility companies to minimize disruption. Residents who find their service has been disrupted should contact the Field Ambassador <u>and</u> notify their phone or internet service provider.</p>
	<p>Water Service Disruptions: From time-to-time, the water supply to your property will be shut-off to complete construction; the contractor will provide notice at least 24-hours in advance. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected, therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advance notice, the City may have needed to use an emergency water shut off to complete work.</p>
	<p>Substandard Water Service Replacement: Please take the time to read the attached fact sheet carefully as it contains important information on lead in drinking water and how to prepare for replacement. If you want to replace the private portion of the water service pipe, the City of Toronto recommends that you obtain several quotes before selecting a contractor. PLEASE NOTE: The City is not able to get involved in any contract to have work done on private property. Property owners are responsible for ensuring contractors do not interfere with the work being done on City property. Learn more at www.toronto.ca/leadpipes.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Traffic on Purcell Square, Passmore Avenue and Copthorne Avenue will be reduced to one lane.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>

	<p>Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.</p> <p>Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).</p> <p>In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
	<p>Garbage and Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.</p>
	<p>Water Flushing: You will see water flushing or running in several areas along this project due to cleaning the new watermain. Before substandard water services are replaced and the new watermain is put into service, the new pipe must meet Toronto Water's servicing and quality standards. Please DO NOT DRINK OR USE THE FLUSHING WATER, it is not potable.</p>
	<p>Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - April to June and September to October.</p>

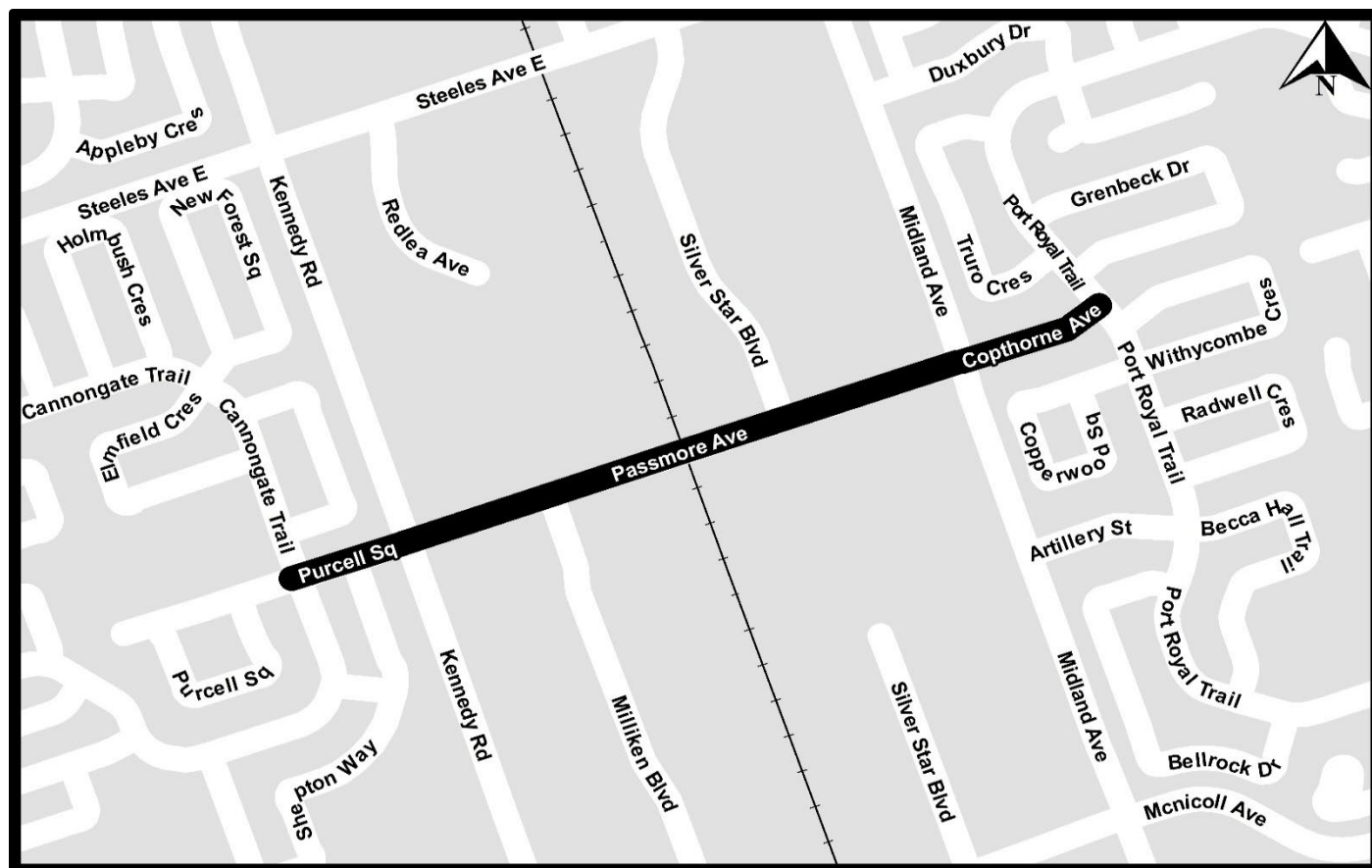

本通知提供有关Purcell Square供水管道更换和道路重铺工程的最新信息。

施工进度顺利，如果天气允许，预计新的供水主管道将于**2026年5月15日**完成安装。完工后，下一阶段将对新的供水主管道进行测试和氯化处理，以确保其符合所有城市和安全标准，然后才能投入使用。这是确认系统安全并可投入使用的例行但重要的步骤。在供水管道测试和氯化处理阶段，现场活动将降至最低。

	<p>施工时间：工程将在周一至周五早上 7:00 至晚上 7:00 进行，必要时也可能在晚上及周末施工。</p>
	<p>工地安全：现场工作人员对其被分配的工作负责。如果您有施工方面的问题或现场问题，请要求与现场检查员联系。如果现场检查员不在，请联系本通知末尾列出的人员。</p>
	<p>针对自动洒水系统 / 加热车道和私人景观拥有者的重要信息。为避免损坏，业主应移走位于市政土地范围（路肩绿带）内的物品。</p> <p>这包括园艺（植物与铺砖）、装饰物、喷灌系统或加热车道等。如果您有自动洒水系统或加热车道，请通知下方列出的现场联络员（Field Ambassador）。</p>
	<p>电话和网络服务：这项工程可能会影响个别物业未深埋在人行道下方的电话和网络线缆。承包商将与公共事业公司协调，以尽量避免服务中断。遇到服务中断的居民应联络现场联络员并通知您的电话或网络服务提供商。</p>
	<p>供水中断：为了完成施工，您的房屋供水可能会不时中断；承包商将至少提前 24 小时发出通知。施工期间，建议您暂时断开所有水处理系统（如软水器或过滤器）、水冷式空调或类似的管道装置。自动草坪喷灌系统也可能受到影响，因此您可能需要手动浇水。如若您没有收到提前通知，市政府可能是采取了紧急停水措施来完成施工。</p>

	<p>道路及人行道限制：为了能够安全完工，施工区域内的道路和人行道将限制通行。应急车辆将始终保持通行。</p> <p>车道通行：如施工期间需临时限制您车道的通行，承包商会提前通知您。如果您的物业有两个出入口，将至少保留一个畅通。</p>
	<p>交通管理：道路使用者应预计附近街道将出现延误和交通拥堵。司机需注意，自行车将会与汽车共用车道。驾驶时，请注意弱势道路使用者。Purcell Square、Passmore Avenue 和 Copthorne Avenue 的交通将缩减为单车道。</p>
	<p>停车：该项目将影响路边停车。由于施工设备和材料需要存放空间，作业区内禁止停车。如果您停放的车辆影响了施工作业，我们会将其移走，车主不需承担费用。请致电 416-808-2222 查询车辆被转移至何处。</p>

	<p>违规停车罚单：请确保始终将车停放在合法的停车位。如违停执法人员到场，必须对违反停车附例的车辆开具黄色停车违例通知（罚单）。如果您在施工期间收到黄色罚单，请在开单日 15 天内按以下任一方式处理，以免额外罚款或留下欠缴记录：</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 支付违规停车罚单（遵循罚单背面的说明）或 2. 在线、邮寄或当面向市府提出违规停车争议（遵循罚单背面的说明）。在争议处理过程中，您可附上本施工通知及 / 或其他与施工影响停车相关的文件。 <p>如果您没有施工通知副本，请联络 311 索取。</p> <p>请注意：如果车辆停在了非法停车地点（即消防栓前或“禁止停车”区域），罚单则无法撤销。</p> <p>为了减少因施工而产生的罚单，如有邻居受施工影响需要临时将车辆停放在您家街道，还请您谅解。</p>
	<p>无障碍便利设施：市政府承包商必须确保在施工期间为都有安全且无障碍的人行通道与出入口。如临时设限，将尽早与民众沟通。如您遇到通行受阻、或有特定通行需求及相关无障碍要求，请联系下方现场联络员。</p>
	<p>垃圾收集：请照常遵循您当地的垃圾收集规定。如有需要，施工单位会把垃圾桶移至适当的地点，然后放回原位。请务必在垃圾桶上标明您家地址。</p>
	<p>冲洗：由于需要清洗新的供水主管道，您会在本工程沿线的几个区域看到水流冲刷或流淌的现象。在更换不合格的供水服务并投入使用新的供水主管道之前，新管道必须符合多伦多水务公司的服务和质量标准。请勿饮用或使用冲洗水，它不适宜饮用。</p>
	<p>复原：如有需要，施工区域将用草皮、混凝土和 / 或沥青进行复原。施工期间从公共或私人物业移除的连锁砖、置于粒料基层的石板或其他类似设施将予以更换。草坪播种和/或铺设草皮将根据需要在理想的生长季节进行——4 月至 6 月和 9 月至 10 月。</p>
