

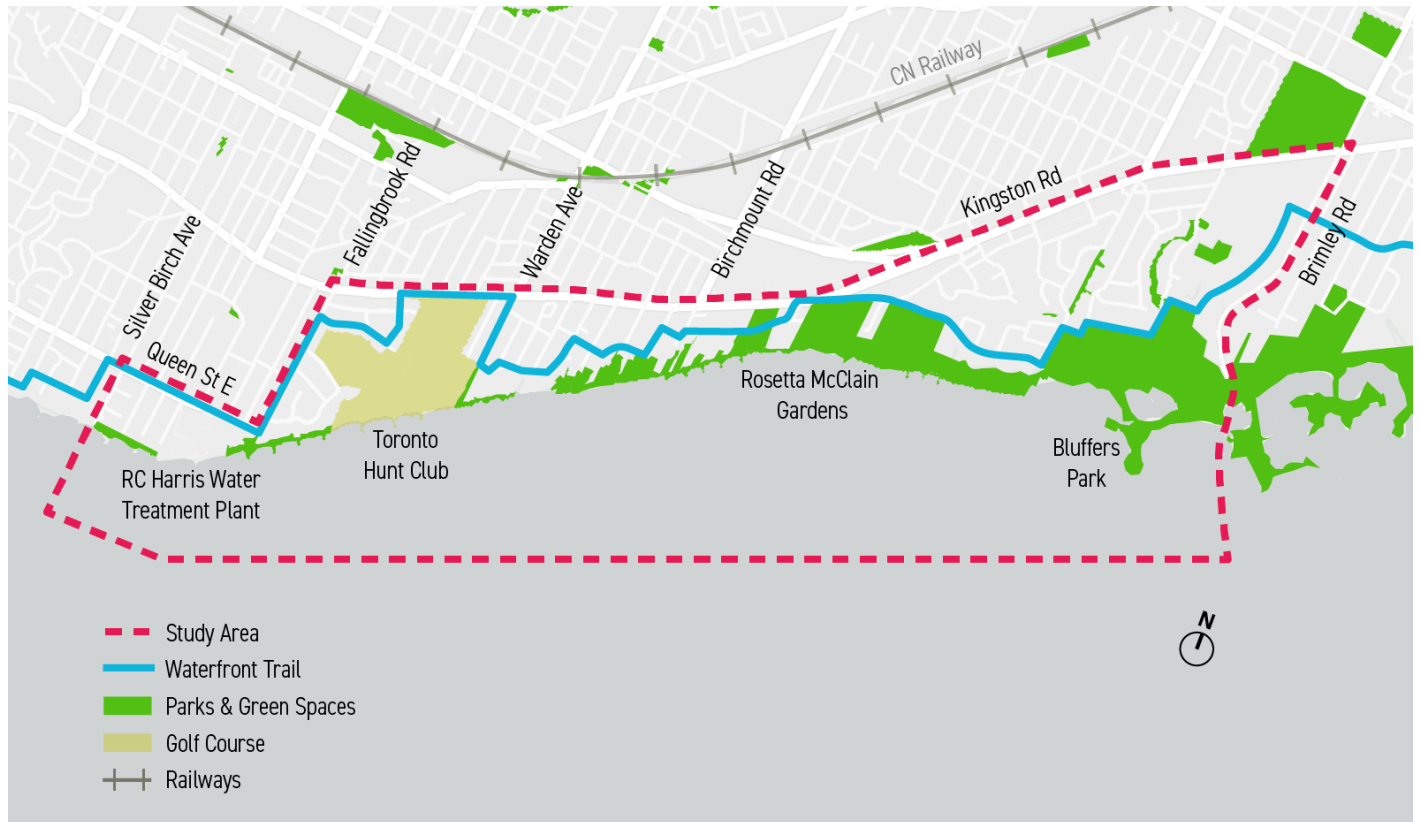

## Scarborough Bluffs West Project

The Scarborough Bluffs West Project will explore the enhancement and protection of sensitive shoreline and natural areas and opportunities for improved waterfront experience and access between the Eastern Beaches (Silver Birch Avenue) and Bluffer’s Park along Lake Ontario.

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority and the City of Toronto are seeking public input on the proposed alternatives and evaluation criteria as a part of the ongoing Environmental Assessment.

### Study Area



The study area extends from Kingston Road to Lake Ontario, and from Silver Birch Avenue to Brimley Road.

### Study Overview

The project will consider opportunities to:

- Improve how people access, move through, and experience the waterfront
- Preserve and enhance the natural environment, including the cultural significance of the Bluffs
- Minimize natural hazards and risks to public safety caused by erosion

## Process

This Study follows the Comprehensive Environmental Assessment (EA) process which promotes good environmental planning by determining and managing the potential effects of a project prior to implementation. There are two phases to a Comprehensive Environmental Assessment:

- **Phase 1: Terms of Reference**, which provides a roadmap for environmental effects to be examined, problems and opportunities to be addressed, and how the Environmental Assessment will be prepared. It also outlines how consultation will be conducted during the Environmental Assessment.
- **Phase 2: Environmental Assessment**, in which alternatives are generated that address the problems and opportunities. The alternatives are then evaluated against the environmental effects identified in the Terms of Reference. Public consultation is conducted throughout the process.

Both the Terms of Reference and Environmental Assessment must be reviewed and approved by the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks before the project can proceed.



## Draft Criteria

Evaluation criteria will be used in the Environmental Assessment to measure the ability of each alternative to meet the project objectives. Proposed criteria include:



**OBJECTIVE 1:**  
Conserve, create and enhance terrestrial and aquatic natural features and linkages  
(Criteria: Natural Environment)



**OBJECTIVE 4:** Consistency and co-ordination with other initiatives  
(Natural, Social & Cultural Environments)



**OBJECTIVE 2:**  
Manage public safety and property risk  
(Criteria: Social & Technical Environment)



**OBJECTIVE 5:** Achieve value for cost  
(Technical Environment)



**OBJECTIVE 3:**  
Enhance waterfront experience  
(Criteria: Social Environment)
