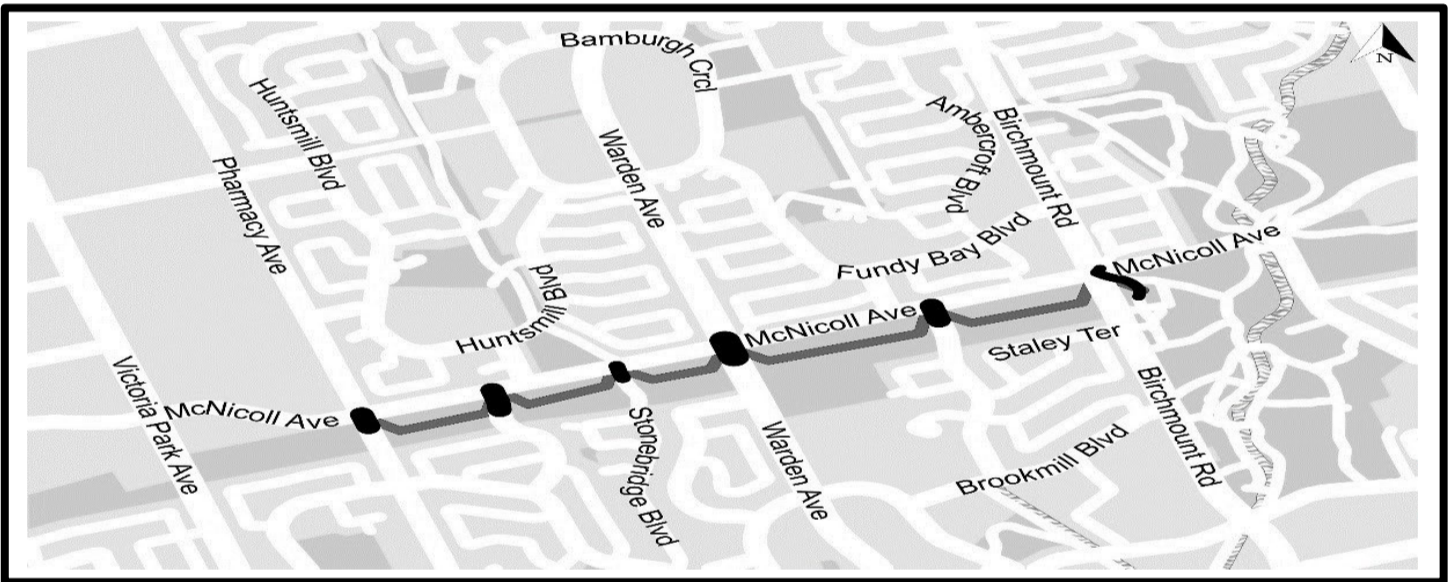
Finch Hydro Corridor Multi-Use Trail construction adjacent to McNicoll Avenue from Pharmacy Avenue to Birchmount Road

This notice provides an update on the construction of a new multi-use trail from Pharmacy Avenue to Birchmount Rd, south of McNicoll Avenue.

Work on this project is scheduled to resume April 23, 2026 and is anticipated to be completed by the end of June 2026.

Work crews will complete:

- Traffic signal upgrades, streetlight upgrades, trail pavement markings, and final restorations.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
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	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traffic on McNicoll Avenue, Warden Avenue and Birchmount Road to be reduced to one lane in each direction.
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p>Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions, however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p>People Cycling: Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.</p>
	<p>Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p>Parking Violation Notice: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.</p> <p>Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).</p> <p>In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>

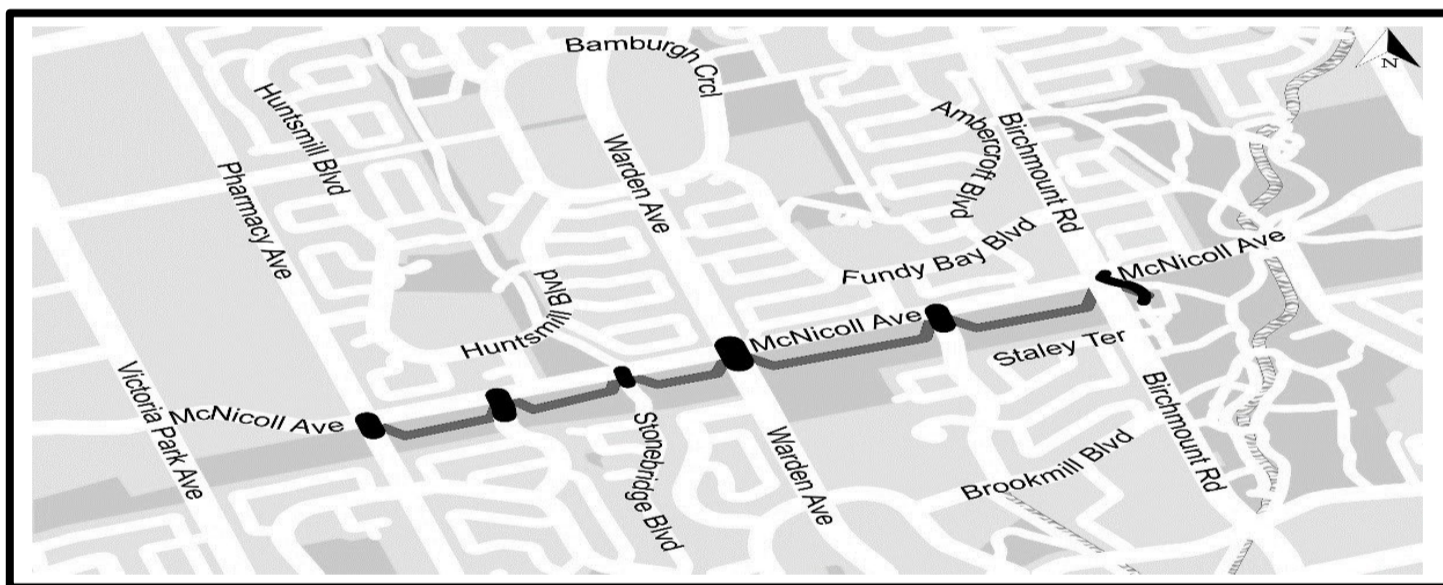

	<p>交通管理：道路使用者应为附近主干道及小路交通放缓、车流增加的情况做准备。司机需注意，自行车将会与汽车共用车道。驾驶时，请注意弱势道路使用者。为保障工人、道路使用者及居民的安全，市府已采取措施对该区域进行交通管理。</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • McNicoll Avenue、Warden Avenue及Birchmount Road的道路将缩减为双向各一条车道。
	<p>道路及人行道通行：为确保施工安全，施工区域内将实施道路和人行道管制。应急车辆将始终保持通行。</p> <p>车道通行：如施工期间需临时限制您车道的通行，承包商会提前通知您。如果您的物业有两个出入口，将至少保留一个畅通。</p>
	<p>行人：施工可能需要临时限制人行道，但必要的人行道封闭将单个方向交替进行，以确保行人在施工期间仍可通行。</p>
	<p>自行车使用者：施工区域内将缩减为每个方向一条共享车道，供自行车与汽车共同使用。</p>
	<p>停车：该项目将影响路边停车。由于施工设备和材料需要存放空间，作业区内禁止停车。如果您停放的车辆影响了施工作业，我们会将其移走，车主不需承担费用。请致电 416-808-2222 查询车辆被转移至何处。</p>
	<p>违规停车通知：<u>请确保始终将车停放在合法的停车位。</u>如违停执法人员到场，必须对违反停车附例的车辆开具黄色违规停车通知（罚单）。如果您在施工期间收到黄色罚单，请在开单日15天内完成以下任一操作，以免额外罚款或留下欠缴记录：</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 支付违规停车罚单（遵循罚单背面的说明）或 2. 在线、邮寄或当面向市府提出违规停车争议（遵循罚单背面的说明）。在争议处理过程中，您可以提交施工通知及／或有关施工对停车之影响的其他文件。 <p>如果您没有施工通知副本，请联络 311 索取。</p> <p>请注意：如果车辆停放在违法停车位（例如消防栓前或禁停区），则该违规停车通知无法取消。</p> <p>为了减少因施工而产生的罚单，如有邻居受施工影响需要临时将车辆停放在您家街道，还请您谅解。</p>
