Watermain Replacement, Road Resurfacing and Road Safety Upgrades on Midland Avenue from Steeles Avenue East to south of McNicoll Avenue

Contract: 25ECS-RD-06SW

Start Date: End of June 2026 End Date: December 2026

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto plans to replace the watermain and the City-owned portion of substandard water services on Midland Avenue from Steeles Avenue East to McNicoll Avenue. The City will resurface the road on Midland Avenue and reconstruct the intersections at McNicoll Avenue and Passmore Avenue. This project also includes new intersection safety improvements such as corner radius reductions, curb extensions to reduce motor vehicle speeds and truck aprons. New traffic islands will be added between Passmore Avenue and McNicoll Avenue.

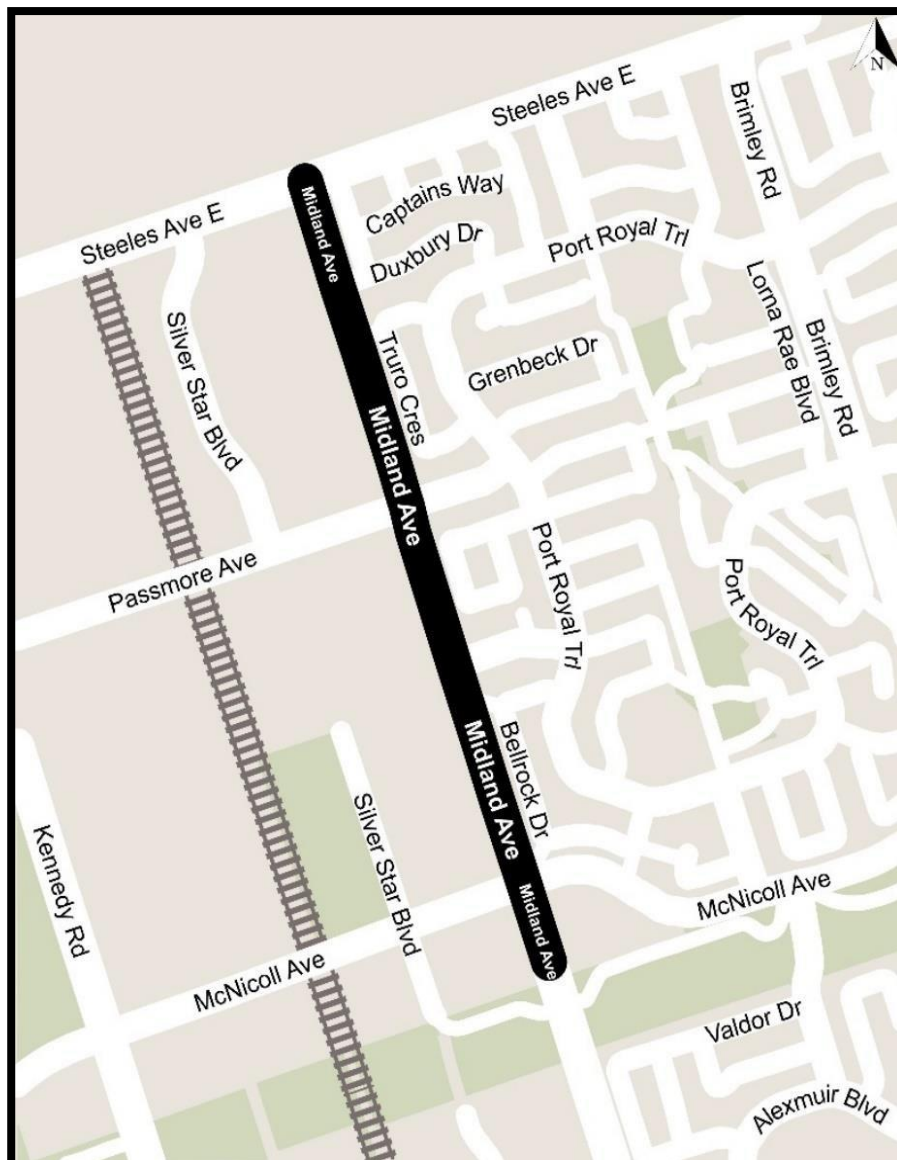
The water service is the underground pipe that brings water to your water meter and is owned by you and by the City. The part you own is from your house to the end of your property, the part the City owns is from the end of your property to the watermain.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2026 Capital Works Program to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT LEAD WATER SERVICES




If you live on Midland Avenue in a property that was built before the mid-1950s, your water service may be made of lead. Please visit toronto.ca/lead for important information about the risks of lead in drinking water, especially if someone in your house is pregnant, there are children under six years old, or there is an infant drinking formula made using tap water.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the City of Toronto staff listed below</p>
	<p>Access to Your Home: The City-hired contractor may need access to the interior and exterior of your home to complete a pre-construction condition survey (inspection). Affected properties will receive a request to schedule a time to complete the pre-construction condition survey. Although participation is voluntary, the pre-construction survey results may be useful to confirm claims for potential damage caused by City construction.</p>
	<p>Important information for owners of sprinkler systems / heated driveways and private landscaping features. Property owners should remove items located within City property limits (boulevard) to avoid damage.</p> <p>This includes items such as landscaping (plants and pavers), decorative objects, sprinkler systems or heated driveways. If you have a sprinkler system or heated driveway, please contact the City of Toronto staff listed below</p>
	<p>Substandard Water Service Replacement: Please take the time to read the attached fact sheet carefully as it contains important information on lead in drinking water and how to prepare for replacement. If you want to replace the private portion of the water service pipe, the City of Toronto recommends that you obtain several quotes before selecting a contractor. Please note: The City is not able to get involved in any contract to have work done on private property. 多伦多市政府计划更换Midland Avenue (从Steeles Avenue East至McNicoll Avenue) 上的供水主管道以及该路段内市属不达标的供水设施。市政府将对Midland Ave.进行路面重铺，并重建McNicoll Avenue与Passmore Avenue的交叉路口。该项目还包括一系列新的路口安全改进措施，例如缩小转弯半径、设置路缘延伸段以减缓机动车车速，以及增设卡车缓冲区。Passmore Avenue与McNicoll Avenue之间将增设新的交通岛。供水设施是将水输送到您的水表的地下管线，分属您和市府。您拥有的部分是从屋内到您物业的尽头，市府拥有的部分是从您的物业尽头至主水管。





该项目是市议会批准的2026年基建工程计划的一部分，旨在更新老化的基础设施、改善供水系统并降低供水主管道破裂的风险。

关于含铅水管线的重要信息

如果您居住在Midland Avenue上，且所住房屋建于1950年代中期之前，您的供水管道可能含有铅。请浏览toronto.ca/lead，了解有关饮用水中铅风险的重要信息，特别是如果您的家中有人怀孕、有六岁以下儿童，或者有婴儿饮用以自来水冲调的配方奶粉。

施工前注意事项

- 施工队伍将在地下标注煤气、水管、电缆等设施的位置，以避免施工干扰。
- 受影响的物业将在开工前大约两周收到施工通知，其中包括有关工程的更多信息。
- 市府对市有物业上任何私人物品的损坏概不负责。

多倫多市政府計劃更換 Midland Avenue (Steeles Avenue East 至 McNicoll Avenue 一段) 的主幹水管及不合格的市有供水管道。市政府將對 Midland Avenue 進行路面重鋪工程，並重建 McNicoll Avenue 及 Passmore Avenue 的十字路口。本項目亦包括新的十字路口安全改善措施，例如減少曲線半徑及延長路緣石，以降低車輛速度並縮小貨車轉彎路緣。Passmore Avenue 至 McNicoll Avenue 之間將增設新安全島。

供水服務設施是將水輸送到您的水錶所在處的地下管道，歸您和市政府所有。您擁有的部分是由屋內到您物業的盡頭，市政府擁有的部分是由您的物業盡頭至主幹水管。
