Rehabilitation of Bridges and Elevated Roads near Eastern Avenue and Adelaide Street East

Contract: 24ECS-BE-09SB

Start Date: Early August 2024 Anticipated End Date: Early 2027

**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is rehabilitating the following bridges and elevated roads near Eastern Avenue and Adelaide Street East: Eastern Avenue Bridge (ID264), Don Valley Parkway Off Ramp over Don River (ID263), Richmond Street East Bridge over King Street East (ID246) and Adelaide Street Bridge over King Street East (ID266).

Starting **early July 2026 until Fall 2026**, lane closures on Eastern Avenue will resume to proceed with **Stage 5 work**. Construction activities for Stage 5 include reinstating the centre median on the Eastern Avenue Bridge, milling the temporary asphalt and final paving, rehabilitation of the Adelaide Bridge pier in the centre of Eastern Avenue, and final finishing and restoration work.

The overall project is expected to continue until early 2027. Following the completion of Stage 5 in fall 2026, rehabilitation work on the underside of the bridges will continue, with final restoration and plantings to be completed in Spring/Summer 2027.

STAGE 5 TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

From **July 2026 until Fall 2026**, the following lane closures will be in place for Stage 5:

- **One eastbound and one westbound lane on Eastern Avenue will be closed between Sumach Street and Broadview Avenue (until late August 2026)**
- **One eastbound and one westbound lane on Eastern Avenue will be closed between Sumach Street and St Lawrence Street (until Fall 2026)**
- Intermittent overnight DVP lane and ramp closures
- Intermittent overnight full closures of Eastern Avenue, Adelaide Street East, and Richmond Street East
- A partial-weekend closure of the Eastern Avenue Bridge will be required for the final milling and paving activities. The connecting ramps from Adelaide Street East, DVP Southbound Richmond Off-Ramp, and DVP Northbound On-Ramp at Eastern Avenue will be closed intermittently during this work.

Intermittent traffic disruptions to St. Lawrence Street, Lower River Street, and Bayview Avenue for the work underneath the bridges will continue throughout this stage.

Details regarding all closures will be provided on the website and email updates.

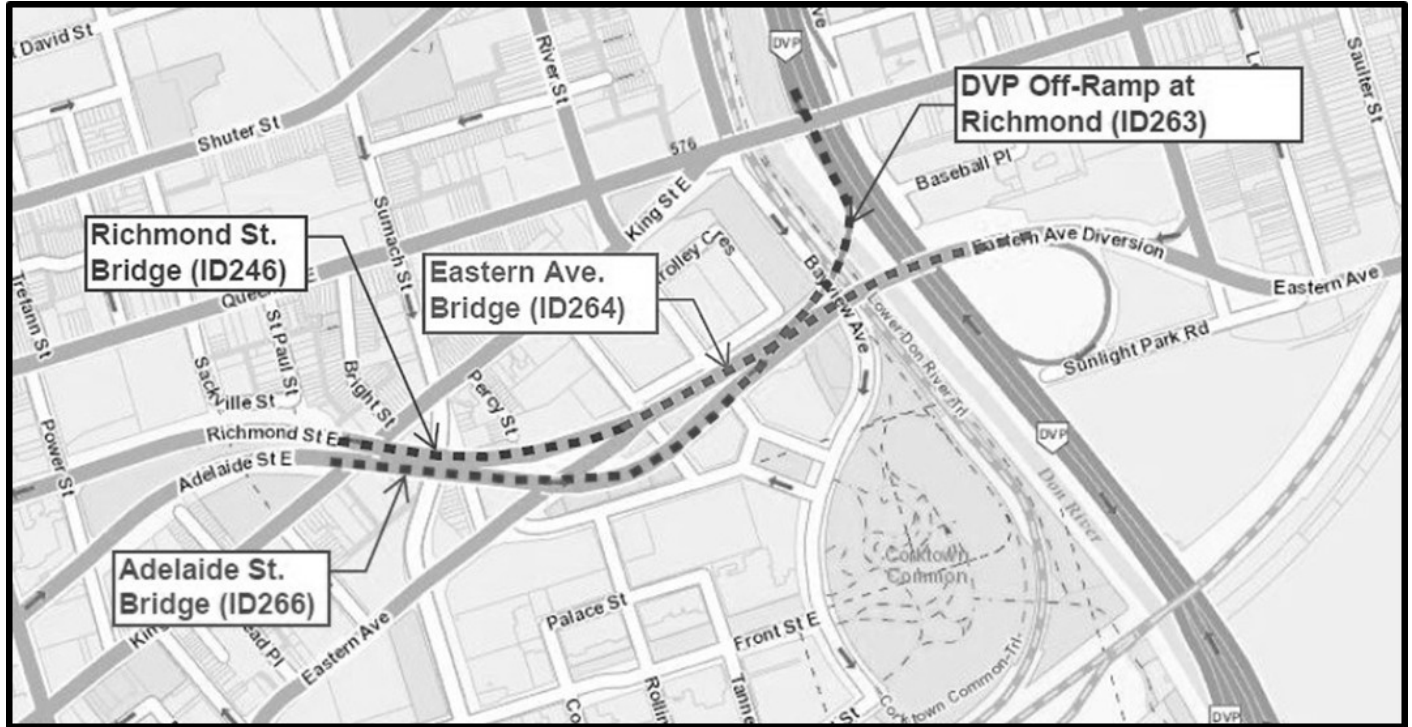
STAGE 5 NOISY DEMOLITION WORK

Stage 5 will require intermittent noisy asphalt milling work. All construction activities, including demolition, are permitted **24 hours a day, 7 days a week**.


TORONTO Construction Update Notice

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p>Work Hours: Work is permitted 24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday, including holidays.</p> <p>Overnight Work: Some tasks will require overnight work. Timelines for overnight work will be communicated on the project website listed below and through subscriber email updates. Visit the project web page listed below to subscribe to receive email updates.</p> <p>During overnight work, construction impacts and noise levels are expected to be similar to daytime construction activities. You may expect that there will be some noise from reversing trucks, saw-cutting, jackhammering, and/or loading of materials into trucks for disposal.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>Vehicle lane closures on the bridges will be required to complete the work.</p> <p>Streets below the bridges, including St. Lawrence Street, Lower River Street, Bayview Avenue, as well as the Don Valley Parkway will experience periodic traffic disruptions throughout the project. These disruptions will not all occur at the same time. All impacted roads will continue to stay open to traffic. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Pedestrian & Cyclist Access:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The multi-use trail on Bayview Avenue will remain open but will be narrowed and bi-directional in the vicinity of the bridges to accommodate construction. Please slow down and yield to northbound cyclists through this section of the trail. The multi-use trail on the south side Eastern Avenue will continue to remain open. Access to the trail eastbound is via the pedestrian ramp at Lower River Street and westbound on Eastern Avenue west of the DVP On-Ramp. The Lower Don River Trail will continue to remain open with intermittent overnight closures as required to safely complete specific work activities.

Construction Update Notice

	<p>Parks and Trails: Sections of Underpass Park will be closed at various times throughout construction depending on the nature of the work. The basketball court will continue to remain closed until the end of 2026. The skate park will remain open until late summer 2026 and will be closed until the end of 2026. The playground will continue to remain open.</p> <p>Farmers Market: The Underpass Park Farmers Market will continue to operate from May to October.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's Contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.</p>
