DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment to July 16, 2026 at 9:30 a.m., to be spoken to, on consent, subject to the following interim conditions, until further order of the Tribunal:

- (1) On weekdays, all movie showtimes will begin after 6:00 p.m.;
- (2) Security personnel will be present from opening to close of business with a security vehicle. The security guards will patrol the parking lot in the vehicle and also leave the vehicle unmanned and patrol inside the theatre. A security patrol vehicle will be stationed at the cinema entrance during operating hours;
- (3) On busier days, additional security guards will be deployed to enhance safety for customers;
- (4) Security shall conduct routine monitoring of surveillance cameras, and any suspicious activity in the parking lot or at the cinema entrance will be promptly reported to Toronto Police;
- (5) The licensee will retain records of security personnel and make them available for inspection by MLS upon request;
- (6) Municipal Licensing and Standards may attend the business to monitor compliance with the interim conditions.
