

FIFA Justification Letter for Construction Deliveries

As part of the FIFA special event zone, construction-related deliveries within the designated area will be restricted to support event operations, public safety, and mobility. To assess requests for exemptions, the City of Toronto requires applicants to provide detailed information demonstrating that proposed deliveries are critical to ongoing construction activities and cannot be reasonably deferred.

The information requested below will assist the staff in evaluating the operational need, potential impacts, and feasibility of accommodating construction deliveries within the restricted period.

2. Construction Delivery Schedule

Provide a daily delivery schedule for the requested exemption period, including:

- Date and time of each delivery
- Type of vehicle/truck (e.g., concrete truck, flatbed, etc.)
- Nature of delivery (materials, equipment, etc.)

3. Vehicle and Delivery Details

For each delivery type, specify:

- Number of axles per vehicle
 - Estimated frequency of deliveries (per day)
 - Duration of each delivery activity (loading/unloading)
