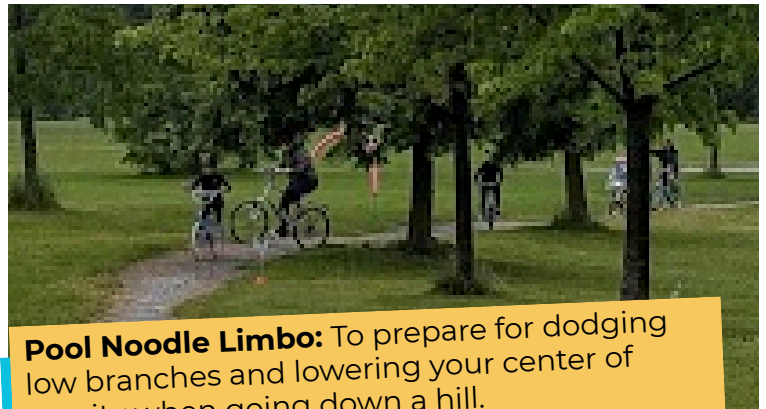
Ride the line: To practice balancing and bike control.
