Start Date: October 14, 2025 | End Date: July 31, 2026

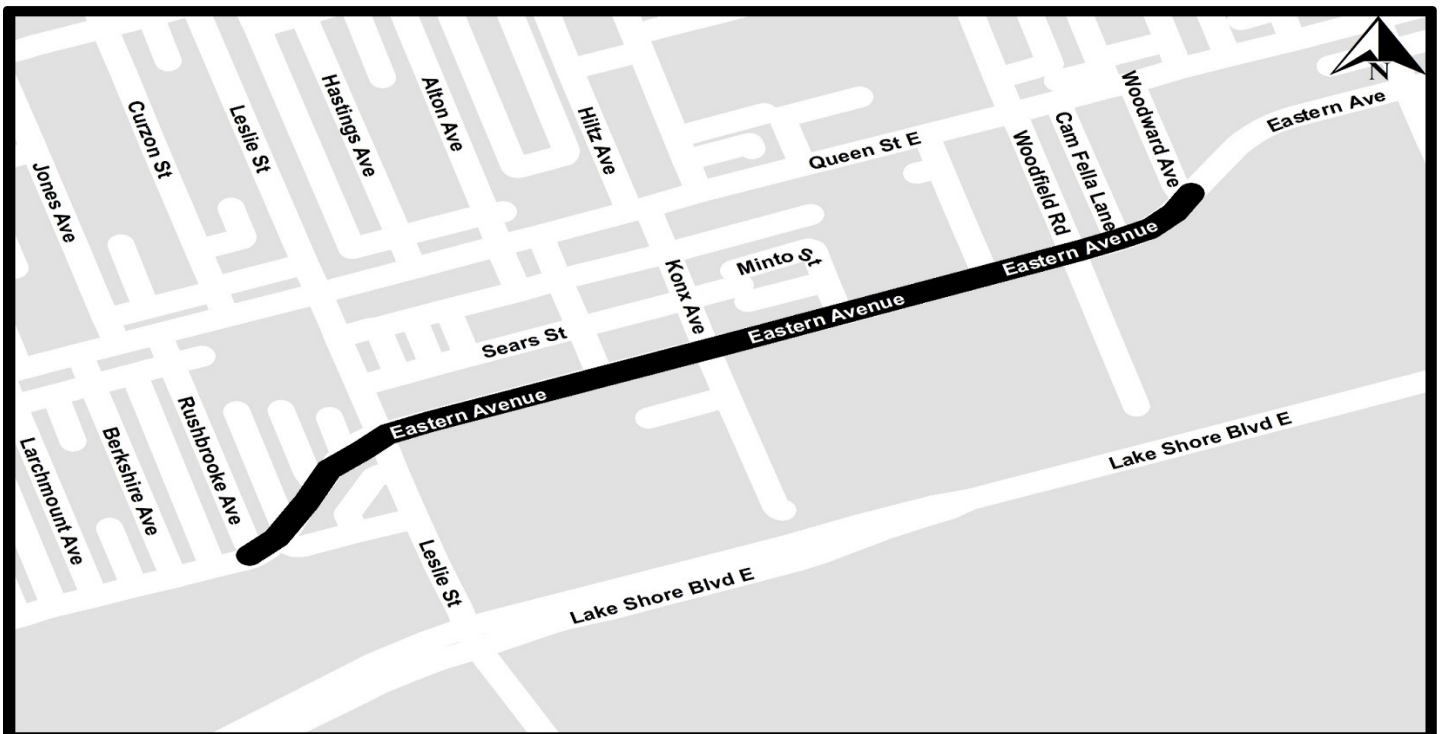
\*Timeline is subject to change. Paving work is weather-sensitive.

From **Monday, June 22, to Monday, July 6, 2026**, rolling closures will be in place on **Eastern Avenue between Mosley Street to Leslie Street**; and **Leslie Street to Woodward Avenue**, to accommodate paving activities.

Construction on Eastern Avenue will be done through rolling closures in segments for the paving work. Eastern Avenue will maintain two-way traffic with one lane open in each direction. All intersecting roads will be open to local traffic. Periodically, left turns will not be permitted within the work zone area and detour signs will be implemented as necessary.

Local traffic will be maintained; however, the use of alternate routes such as Lakeshore Boulevard or Queen Street is recommended. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained.

## WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will complete:

- Paving on Eastern Avenue from Mosley Street to Leslie Street; and Leslie Street to Woodward Avenue.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, traffic delays, and other inconveniences.
- The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> To ensure the work is completed safely, road, sidewalk, and bikeway restrictions will be in effect within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated at no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>Local traffic will be maintained; however, the use of alternate routes such as Lakeshore Boulevard or Queen Street is recommended. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need, or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
