## Weekend Work on Ridelle Avenue from Newgate Road to Bathurst Street

**Contract: 25ECS-RD-01LR**  
**Start: May 30, 2026 End: October 30, 2027**  
**Continuous Saturday's**

The City of Toronto is providing an update regarding the ongoing road reconstruction, infrastructure works occurring on Ridelle Avenue.



To expedite the project, the contractor will be **working continuous Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** from May 30<sup>th</sup> until the contract end date October 2027.

Please be advised that the project schedule remains subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We are mindful of the community, and will make every reasonable effort to minimize noise, maintain accessibility, and reduce disruptions to nearby residents, pedestrians, and road users.

We sincerely appreciate your continued patience, understanding, and cooperation as these essential infrastructure improvements are completed.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Heavy equipment will be operated during the weekend construction period, and you may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. We will be implementing dust-control measures and noise-reduction efforts to keep disruptions to a minimum.
- Please note that all construction vehicles are equipped with mandatory backup warning/signalling beepers. These devices are required for the safety of construction crews and cannot be disabled.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on City property, so please ensure that you remove/arrange for the removal of such items.

	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be some road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to driveway access.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p>
