

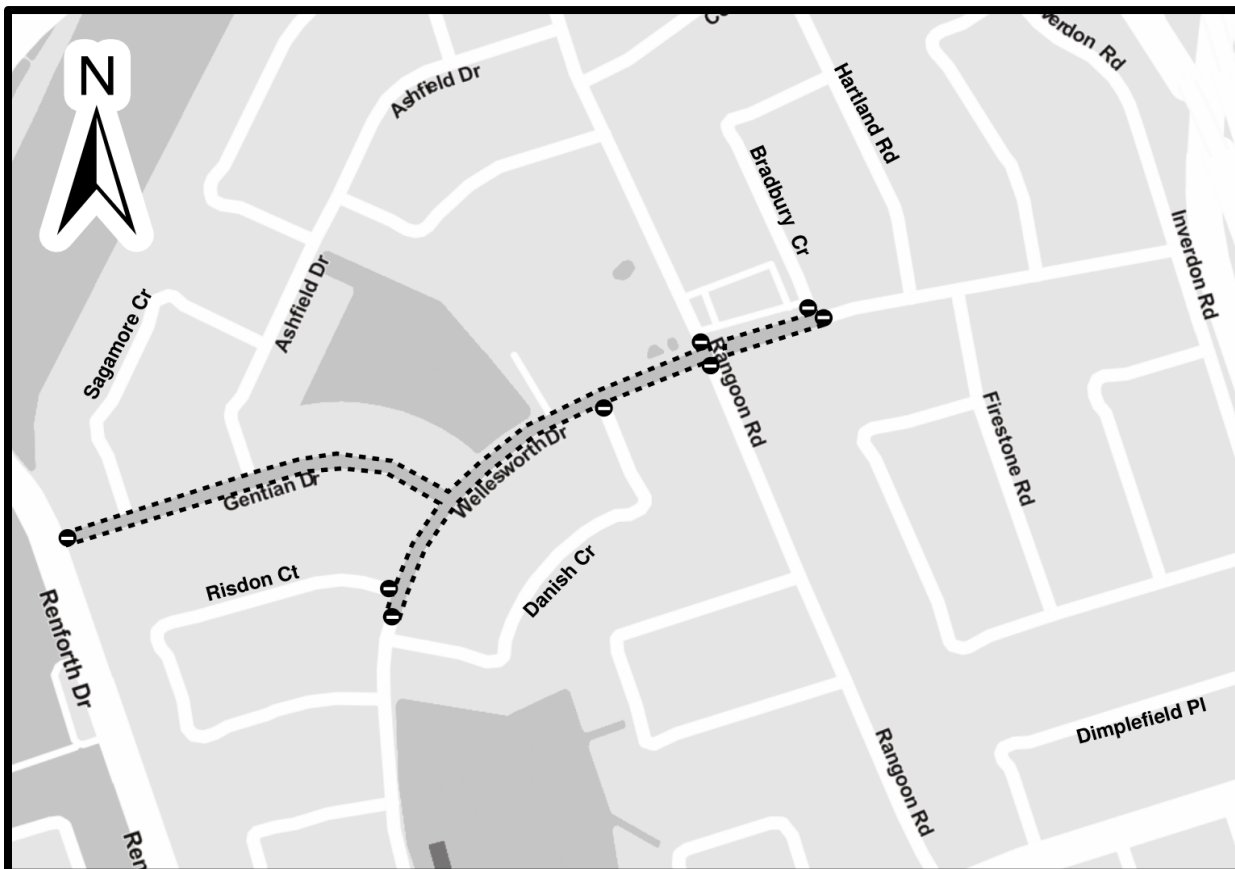

ROAD CLOSURE Wellesworth Drive Between Bradbury Crescent and Risdon Court

Contract 24ECS-LU-01FP
Expected Start Date: June 29, 2026
Expected End Date: September 4, 2026

The City of Toronto is modifying and upgrading the storm sewer and related systems in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, **Wellesworth Drive will be closed from Risdon Court to Bradbury Crescent from 7 a.m. on Monday, June 29, 2026, to 7 p.m. on Friday, September 4, 2026**, for construction purposes. Please note that a portion of Gentic Drive is also closed due to ongoing construction and is expected to reopen by mid-July.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate the roadway on Wellesworth Drive between Bradbury Crescent and Risdon Court.
- Remove the existing storm and sanitary sewers and install upgraded systems.
- Work will also include the storm sewer tie-in to the existing sewer network on Wellesworth Drive.
- Restore the road and all areas affected by construction.

	<p>Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.</p> <p>Traffic Detour:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local roads will be more congested than usual during the road closure. Please use the signed detour routes in place. Follow directions from traffic control personnel (flaggers), who will be present at certain times and areas during the closure. • During the road closure, residents along Wellesworth Drive will have access to their driveways except when construction is occurring in front of their property. Driveway Impact Notices will be distributed on an ongoing basis as necessary. • When driveway access is not available, please park in a legal spot on a local side street and display the Driveway Impact Notice in your windshield.
	<p>TTC Service: This project will affect travel times and routes on the 112 West Mall bus. Visit TTC.CA for accurate schedule information.</p>
	<p>Pedestrians: The sidewalk on the south side of Wellesworth Drive will remain open. The sidewalk on the north side of Wellesworth Drive will be closed to pedestrians with access for local residents only during driveway closures.</p> <p>Temporary pedestrian crossings will be maintained at the intersections of Wellesworth Drive and Bradbury Crescent and Wellesworth Drive Risdon Court.</p>

	<p>Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, June 29, 2026, to Friday, September 4, 2026. Work hours may be extended, and weekend work may be required.</p>
	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
	<p>Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you always park in a legal parking spot.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact Field Ambassador to request a copy.</p> <p>Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e., in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones).</p> <p>To reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
