New Sidewalk Construction and Road Resurfacing on Rosemarie Drive and Sun Avenue

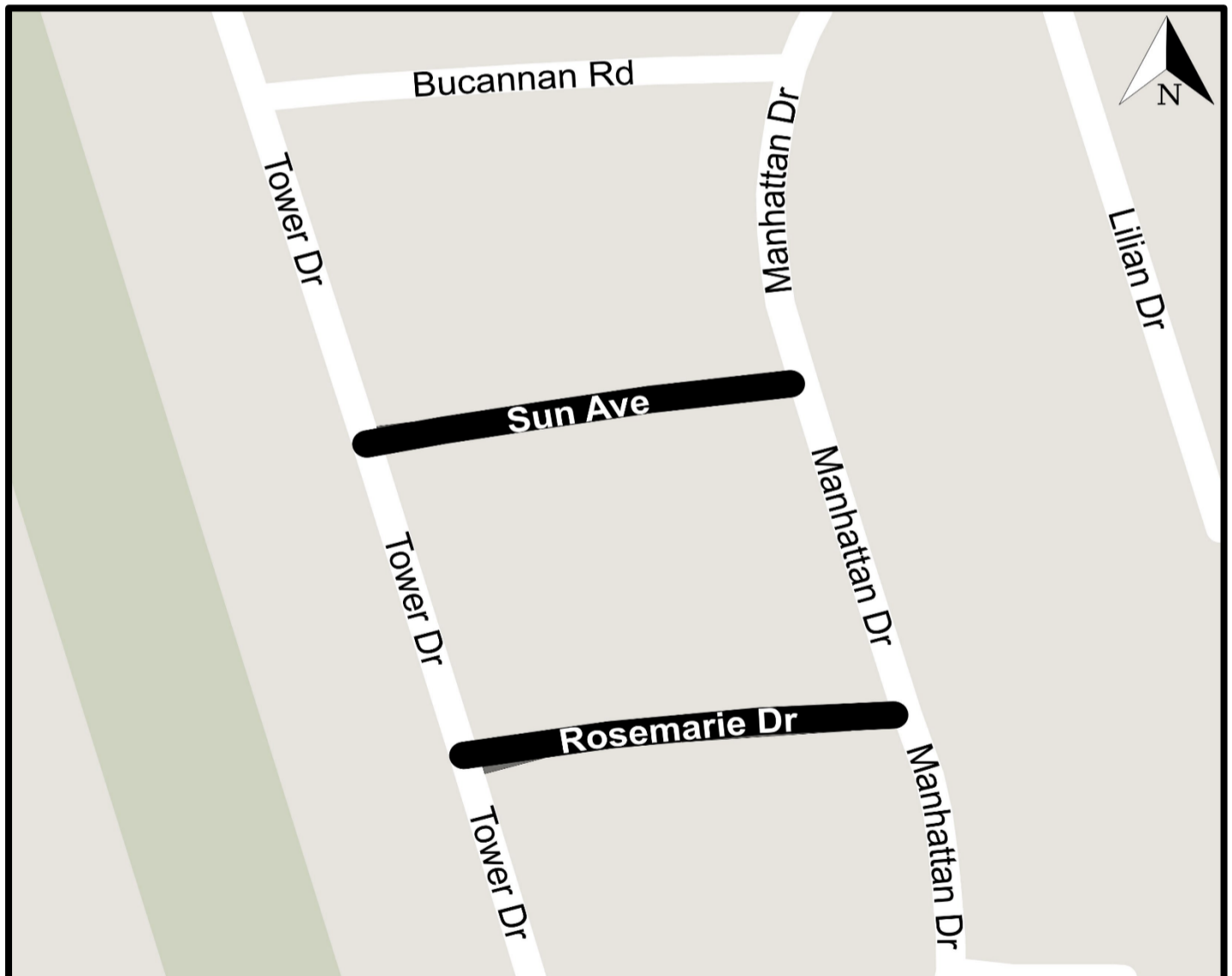

The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the roads and construct new sidewalks on the south side of Sun Avenue and Rosemarie Drive from Tower Drive to Manhattan Drive.

Sidewalks are a critical piece of transportation infrastructure which provide accessibility and safety for all, including vulnerable road users. Our data shows that sidewalks are missing on both sides of the road or is at a width that does not meet current City standards.



This project is part of the Council-approved 2026 Capital Works Program to renew aging City roads and sidewalk for current and future needs. Installing new sidewalks are one way the City is committed to making the community safer and more accessible.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water, and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p>Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible.
