## Road Resurfacing, Watermain Replacement and Sidewalk Replacement on Sorauren Avenue from Dundas Street W to Queen Street W and Virtue Street from Sorauren Avenue to East End Limit

**Contract: 25ECS-RD-05RR**  
**MILLING & PAVING ON SORAUREN AVENUE**  
**START DATE: Friday June 26, 2026 | END DATE: Week of July 16, 2026**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

This notice provides an update on the ongoing watermain replacement and road resurfacing on Sorauren Avenue. As we near the completion of this project we are preparing to start the final stage of work for this project. Construction crews will be milling and paving on Sorauren Avenue, starting on **Friday June 26, 2026**. Milling and paving operations will include road base repair and manhole adjustments and are expected to be completed by the week of July 16, 2026 weather permitting.

Crews will start work at the south end of Sorauren Avenue and will be working north towards Dundas Street W. To limit parking impacts our contractor has decided to complete this work in three stages. See construction staging below:

### LOCAL TRAFFIC & PARKING RESTRICTIONS DURING MILLING & PAVING






- On Friday June 26, 2026 construction crews will begin to mill on Sorauren Avenue. Residents can expect traffic barrels, construction materials, additional noise/dust and various heavy equipment to be parked within the work area.
- Throughout the duration of milling and paving operations residents will be asked to remove their vehicles from the street during the day. Cars are expected to be off the street by 7am every morning and can return to park overnight after 7pm.
- Cars still parked on Sorauren Avenue on Friday June 26, 2026 will receive a friendly tow to a location in the area. Additional contact information can be found under the parking section in the table below.
- During milling and paving operations, the section of Sorauren Avenue being worked on will be **CLOSED to all traffic and on street parking**.
- **Residents with on street parking permits are permitted to park anywhere within Zone 2.**
- Additional paid duty police officers and traffic personelle will be on site to direct traffic during paving.
- If work is progressing quickly crews will continue past stage limit when possible to expediate the schedule.




- Start and end dates are contingent upon weather conditions.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• During milling &amp; paving traffic on Sorauren Avenue will be <b>FULLY CLOSED</b></li> <li>• Drivers are advised to use alternative travel routes through the area and should expect delays if they travel on Sorauren Avenue during construction.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. <b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Pedestrians:</b> The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.</p>
	<p><b>People Cycling:</b> Travel will be reduced to one shared lane in each direction for people cycling and driving through the work zone.</p>

	<p><b>Parking:</b> This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location. Additional information regarding on street parking during construction will be provided in the next construction update</p>
	<p><b>Parking Violation Notice:</b> <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) <b>or</b></li> <li>2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction.</li> </ol> <p>If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. <b>Please note:</b> Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (e.g. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.</p>
