## Watermain Replacement and Road Resurfacing on Purcell Square; and Road Resurfacing on Passmore Avenue and Copthorne Avenue

**Contract: 25ECS-LU-08SU**




**Start Date: March 3, 2026 | Revised End Date: July 28, 2026**




The City of Toronto’s infrastructure improvements on Purcell Square are progressing well. As part of this ongoing project, crews will soon begin essential overnight work to upgrade the watermain and service connections. This work is scheduled on **Purcell Square, stretching from Cannongate Trail to Kennedy Road.**

The contractor will be working on these specific activities during overnight hours **from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 11 and Friday, June 12, 2026.** Please be advised that regular daytime construction activities will continue as scheduled from 7:00 a.m. onward each day.

There may be temporary water service disruptions during these overnight periods. Any properties directly impacted by a temporary water shutdown will be notified individually and in advance. Residents should also expect typical construction noise and vehicle headlights in the area during the night.

The City apologizes for any inconvenience this necessary work may cause and appreciates your continued patience as these critical neighbourhood infrastructure upgrades are completed.

	<p><b>Water Service Disruptions:</b> The water supply to your property may be shut-off to complete construction; if required, the contractor will provide notice at least 24-hours in advance. Throughout the work, it is recommended that you temporarily disconnect any water treatment systems (i.e. softeners or filters), water-cooled air conditioners or similar plumbing fixtures. Automatic lawn sprinkler systems may also be affected; therefore, you may need to water manually. In the event you did not receive advance notice, the City may have needed to use an <b>emergency water shut off</b> to complete work.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <p><b>Purcell Square will be reduced to one lane of traffic.</b></p>

	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
	<p><b>Water Flushing:</b> You will see water flushing or running in several areas along this project due to cleaning the new watermain. Before substandard water services are replaced and the new watermain is put into service, the new pipe must meet Toronto Water's servicing and quality standards. <b>Please DO NOT DRINK OR USE THE FLUSHING WATER, it is not potable.</b></p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.</p>
