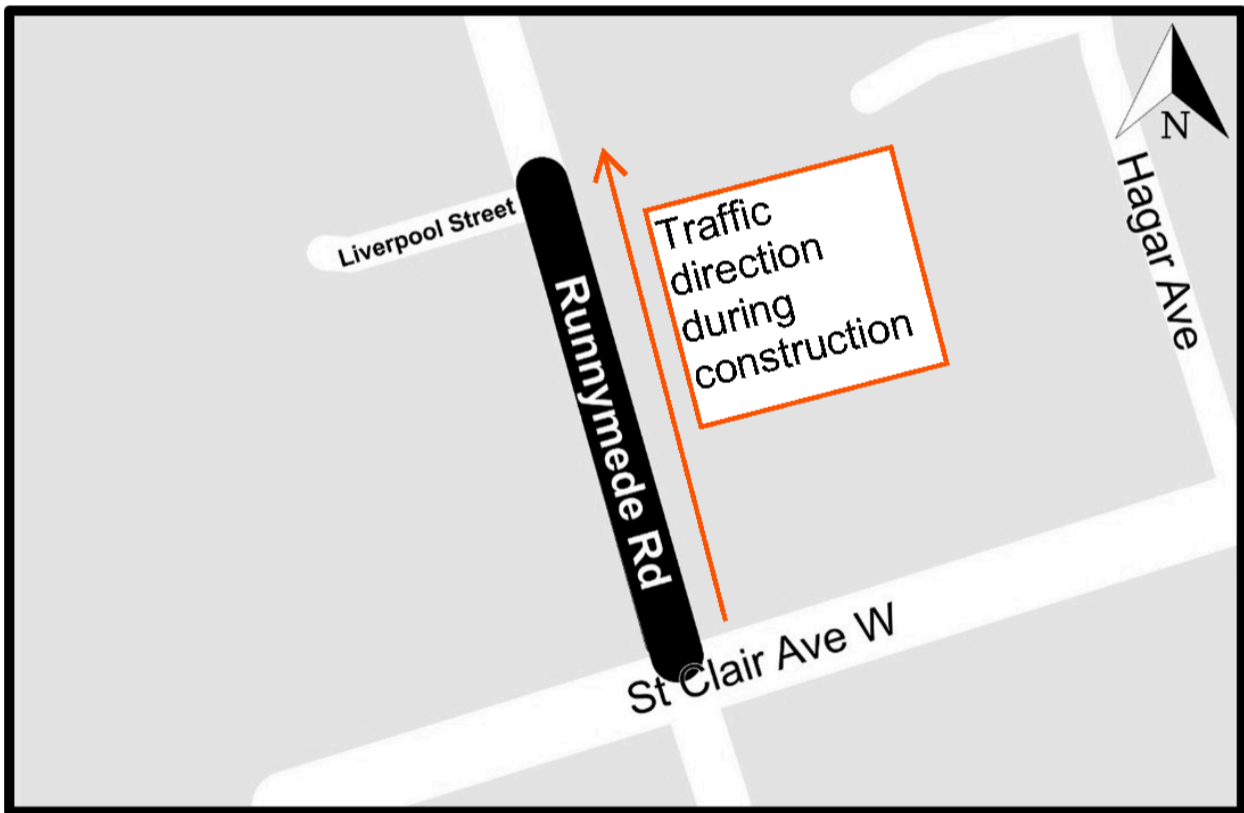
#### at Runnymede Road and St Clair Avenue West intersection

The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the road on Runnymede Road from Liverpool Street to St. Clair Avenue West. Due to construction staging vehicular traffic on Runnymede Road will be restricted to one way traffic from St. Clair Avenue West to Henrietta Street. from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.

During construction there will be no on street parking on Runnymede Road between St Clair West and Liverpool Street. There will be one lane of northbound traffic on Runnymede Road from St Clair Ave West to Liverpool Street. Southbound traffic on Runnymede Road will be closed at Liverpool Street.



Please see table below for transit service changes during construction. Residents are advised to adjust local travel routes during construction activities.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and curbs requiring replacement and the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately owned items on City property.

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.</p>
	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as</p>

	possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the <b>Field Ambassador</b> listed below.
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Traffic will be reduced to one direction on Runnymede Road during active construction. Access will be limited during paving operations.</li> <li>• Traffic control personnel will be present to assist local traffic during construction.</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be <b>NO on street parking</b> during construction</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Transit Service:</b> Bus routes 71 Runnymede / 79 Scarlett Road will maintain Northbound service from St Clair Avenue West to Henrietta Street. Southbound service will be diverted during construction on Runnymede Road. Visit <a href="http://ttc.ca">ttc.ca</a> for accurate schedule.</p>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
