

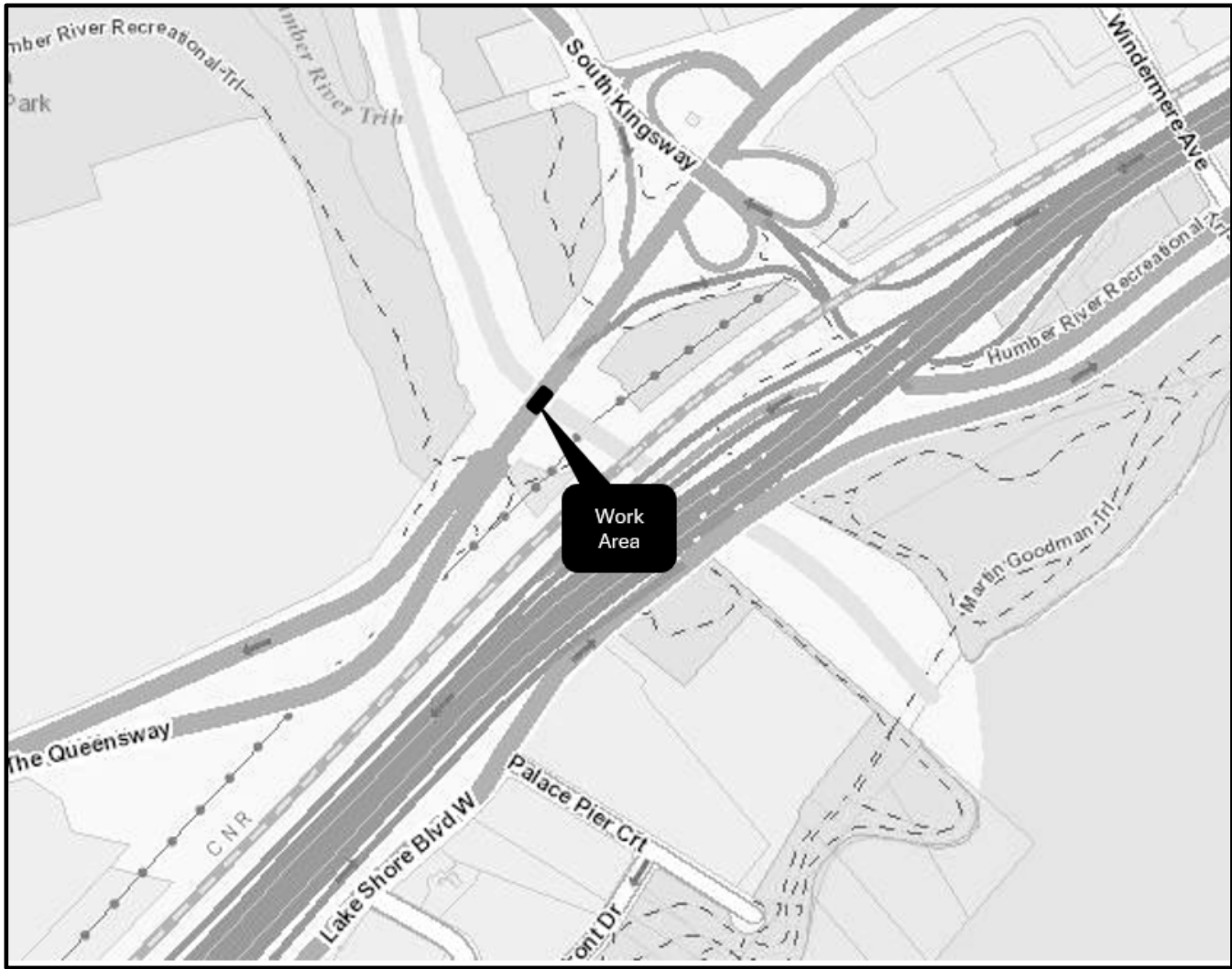

The Queensway Bridge Rehabilitation over Humber River

Contract: 26ECS-BE-15AM
Start Date: July 2026 End Date: November 2026

The City of Toronto is planning to rehabilitate the Queensway over Humber (ID024). This work will ensure that the bridge meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2026 Capital Works Program.

WORK DETAILS

- The City’s contractor will complete:
- Partial depth concrete removal for spall and delamination areas around piers
 - Localized concrete patch repairs at piers
 - New concrete jacking on lower portion of the disintegrated pier locations

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
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	Road and Sidewalk Access: There will be no impact to existing road or sidewalk access. All construction activities will take place beneath the bridge. Traffic Management: There will be no impact to vehicular traffic on The Queensway, or to pedestrian access. All construction activities will be confined to the area beneath the bridge.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
