Update to Road Paving and Road Closure on Amsterdam Boulevard

The City of Toronto construction contract 23ECS-LU-03FP (Phase 2) has completed the upgrade of the area's storm and sanitary sewer system. The next stage of construction involves roadway paving on Amsterdam Avenue.

This construction update provides revised information on the paving date and waste collection for Amsterdam Avenue. Since the road paving on Thursday, July 16th coincides with the recycling collection schedule, Clearway will arrange recycling and green bin collection/disposal. To facilitate this, please place your bins curbside before 6:00 a.m. on Thursday, July 16th. Please ensure your bins are close to the street and clearly visible. Recycling collection will take place only between 6:00 am and 7:00 am.

This paving work will result in temporary impediments to residents' driveway access. **The contractor will provide advance notice of any temporary restrictions on driveway access.**

WORK DETAILS

- The City's contractor will:
- Pave Amsterdam Avenue from Westview Boulevard to Victoria Park Avenue.
 - Due to the paving method being utilized, the road will be fully occupied with construction machinery from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
 - Amsterdam Avenue will be fully closed to all traffic at the intersections of Westview Boulevard and at Victoria Park Avenue, for the duration of the workday.
 - Driveway access will be affected from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, and traffic delays.
- Large, heavy construction vehicles in the area. Please exercise caution when driving.

	Work Hours: Paving work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. A separate driveway impact notice will be distributed to residents. Waste Collection: Recycling and green bin collection from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 am
	On-Site Communication: There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff about the construction site, please contact the Field Ambassador listed below, or ask for the Site Inspector.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: To complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. When driving, please be mindful of pedestrians and other road drivers. Amsterdam Avenue from Westview Boulevard to Victoria Park Avenue will be fully closed to traffic for the duration of the paving operation.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you always park in a legal parking spot.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment: 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). To reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
