

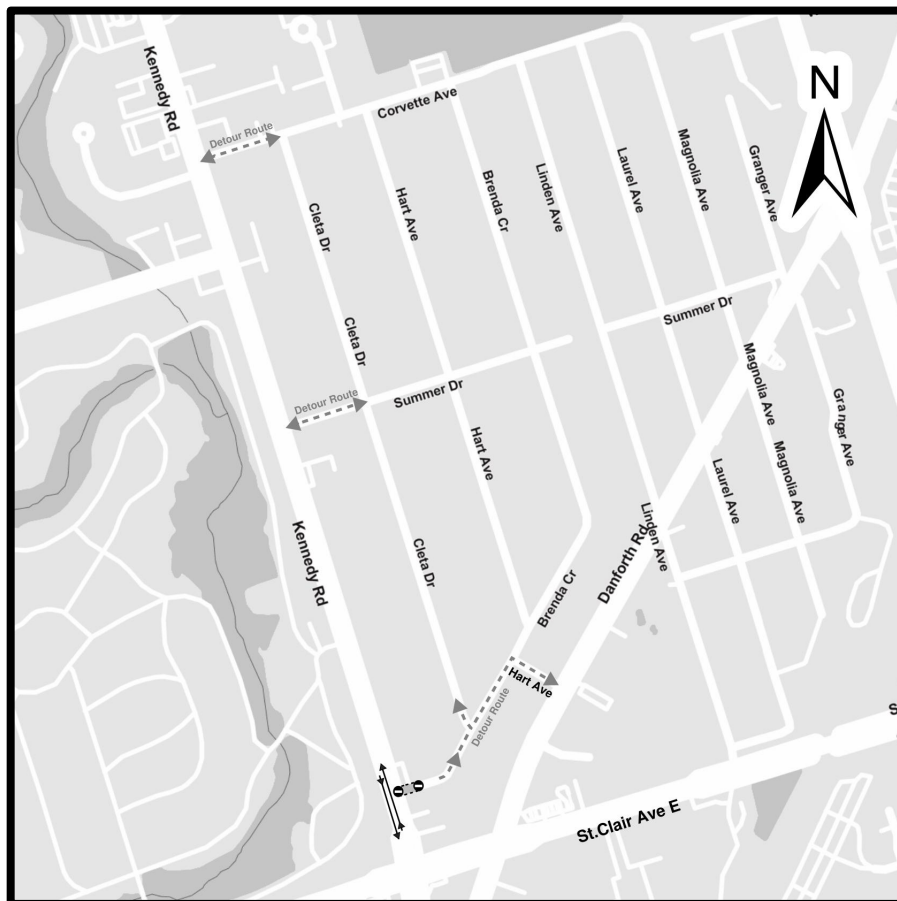

ROAD CLOSURE Brenda Crescent at Kennedy Road

Expected Start Date: July 13, 2026
Expected End Date: August 7, 2026

The City of Toronto is upgrading the storm and sanitary sewers, as well as replacing the water main, in your area to reduce surface and basement flooding. Due to the depth and nature of the construction work, **Brenda Crescent will be fully closed at Kennedy Road from 7:00 a.m. on Monday, July 13, 2026, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026, for construction purposes.**

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Excavate at the intersection of Brenda Crescent and Kennedy Road.
- Remove the existing storm sewer and install the upgraded system. Work will also include the storm tie-in into the existing sewer network on Kennedy Road.
- Restore the road and all areas affected by construction.

	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents. Traffic Detour: • Brenda Crescent will be closed at Kennedy Road fully to all through traffic. Traffic on Kennedy Road will be maintained with one lane in each direction. • Traffic on Brenda Crescent can exit and enter via Summer Drive or Corvette Avenue from the west, to/from Kennedy Road. • Traffic on Brenda Crescent can exit and enter via Hart Avenue from the south, to/from Danforth Road. • During the road closure, residents will have access to their driveways except when construction is occurring in front of their property. Driveway Impact Notices will be distributed on an ongoing basis as necessary. • When driveway access is not available, please park in a legal spot on a local side street and display the Driveway Impact Notice in your windshield.
	Pedestrians: The work will require temporary sidewalk restrictions. However, pedestrian detour access will always be available during construction.
	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7:00 a.m. on Monday, July 13, 2026, to 7:00 p.m. on Friday, August 7, 2026, with work on weekends as required.

	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
	Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you always park in a legal parking spot.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment: 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. If you do not have a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact Field Ambassador to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e., in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). To reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
