DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on July 22, 2006 (Mustajob Abdulvakil) and on July 23, 2026 (by Municipal Licensing and Standards), as follows:

“The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The Motorized Refreshment Vehicle Licence will be placed on probation for a period of **two (2) years**. During the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Potato Bar on Wheels Inc. or Mustajob Abdulvakil and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess their compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (2) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Potato Bar on Wheels Inc. or Mustajob Abdulvakil or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 8109 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
