- 1. Yash Paul Kaushal** (Report No. 8088)
Applicant for the Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver Licence No. D01-4690134

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution signed on July 16, 2026, as follows:

“The Vehicle-For-Hire Driver’s Licence (“**Licence**”) will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards (“**MLS**”) within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the Licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon the Licence being renewed, the Licence will be placed on probation for a period of **three (3) years**. Yash Paul Kaushal is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions incurred by Yash Paul Kaushal, and may conduct other investigations as appropriate to assess Yash Paul Kaushal’s compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Toronto Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) Prior to the next **three (3)** renewals of the Licence, Yash Paul Kaushal must provide to MLS, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of their Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if MLS has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Yash Paul Kaushal, or any other concerns with respect to his conduct as licensee, those matters and Report No. 8088 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
