Road Safety Improvements and Bikeway Installation on Scarborough Golf Club Road from Lawrence Avenue East to Confederation Drive

Contract: 24ECS-RD-02MR

Start Date: mid-August 2026 End Date: early-September 2026

**Timeline is subject to change.*

Starting in August 2026, the City of Toronto will install road safety improvements on Scarborough Golf Club Road between Lawrence Avenue East and Confederation Drive.

In May 2023, City Council approved changes to Scarborough Golf Club Road that were recommended through the Scarborough Golf Club Road Safety Improvements project. The City has completed the road reconstruction and road safety improvements between Ellesmere Road and Lawrence Avenue East. The upcoming work will extend road safety improvements south of Lawrence Avenue East to Confederation Drive.

Planned changes include:

- One-way cycle tracks on both sides of the road with painted buffers and precast curb stones with bollards
- Redesigning the roadway so that the road is consistently one motor vehicle lane in each direction, with existing left turn lanes maintained
- Providing on-street parking on one side (east side) of Scarborough Golf Club Road only. Parking on the west side of the road will not be permitted.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING INSTALLATION

The City’s contractor will:

- Temporarily remove on-street parking
- Remove existing pavement markings and install new markings
- Install precast concrete curbs
- Install new signage, as required.
- Regulatory signs may go up before pavement markings are done. These signs will stay covered until the markings are in place.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Construction work will start at Lawrence Avenue East. Travel lanes will be reduced to one lane in each direction from Lawrence Avenue East to Confederation Drive in active work zones. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
	People Cycling: If travelling on Scarborough Golf Club Road, please share the traffic lane in the active work zones.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Parking Violation Notices: <u>Please ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.</u> If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date in order to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment: 1. Pay the parking violation (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or 2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include the construction notice and/or other documentation related to parking impacts resulting from construction. If you do not have a copy of the Project Update Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy. Please note: Violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in No Parking zones). In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction impacts and may need to temporarily park on your street.
	Garbage and Recycling: Please follow your normal routine. If required, the contractor will move bins to an appropriate location and return them. Please ensure that you label your bins with your address.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the staff person listed below.
