

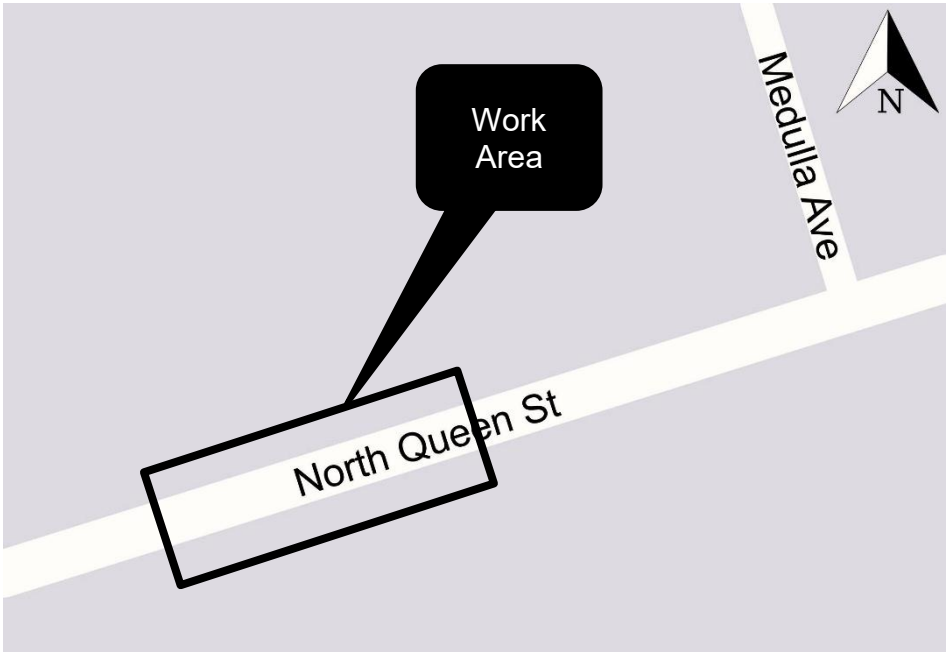

North Queen Street Culvert Removal

Contract: 26ECS-BE-06PM
Start Date: August 2026 End Date: December 2026

The City of Toronto is planning to remove the North Queen Street Culvert as it is no longer required. This work will ensure that the roadway meets today’s standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2026 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m.to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction with both sidewalks opened at all times. The north sidewalk will be protected from traffic and the work zone by temporary concrete barriers. Flagging will be utilized to halt pedestrians when deliveries are scheduled to the work zone.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times during construction. Vehicles within the construction zone exiting properties on the north side of the roadway will be required to turn right. Left turns onto North Queen Street will be prohibited.

	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
