**Timeline is subject to change. Milling & Paving work is weather-sensitive.*

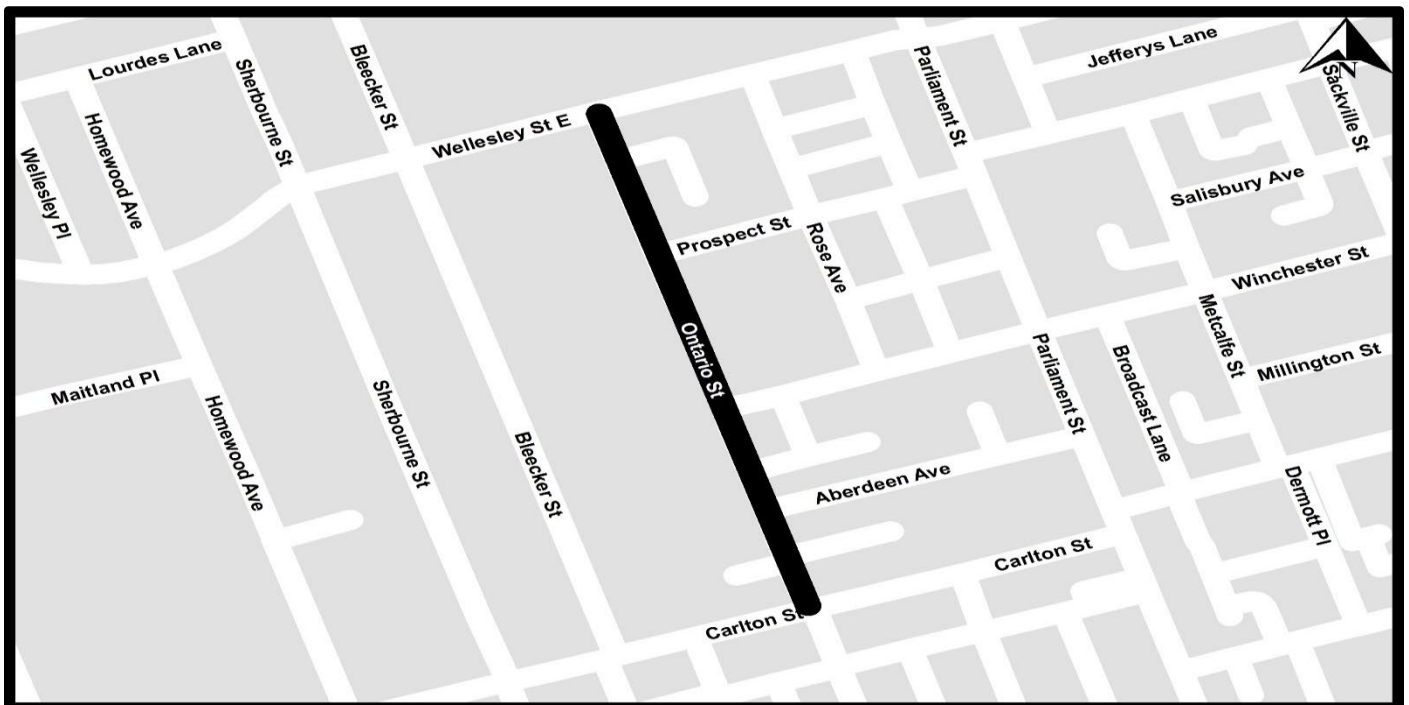
This is to notify you that from **7:00 A.M. on Wednesday, July 22, to 7:00 P.M. on Friday, July 31**, road milling will take place on Ontario Street between Prospect Street and Wellesley Street. Following milling, concrete road base restoration and final top-asphalt paving will be performed along the entire section of Ontario Street. Please note that this timeline is weather dependant.

Due to the nature of the work, temporary and rolling lane closures will be in place along this section to safely accommodate paving operations.

Local traffic will be maintained; however, the use of alternate routes such as Parliament Street or Bleecker Street is recommended. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained.

We apologize for this inconvenience. Your co-operation and patience are greatly appreciated.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Mill on Ontario Street from Prospect Street to Wellesley Street
- Top Asphalt Paving on entire Ontario Street

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, traffic delays, and other inconveniences.
- The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: To ensure the work is completed safely, road, sidewalk, and bikeway restrictions will be in effect within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated at no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Access for local traffic will be maintained.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need, or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
