The City of Toronto is planning to resurface the sidewalk on Ontario Street between Prospect Street and Garner Lane.

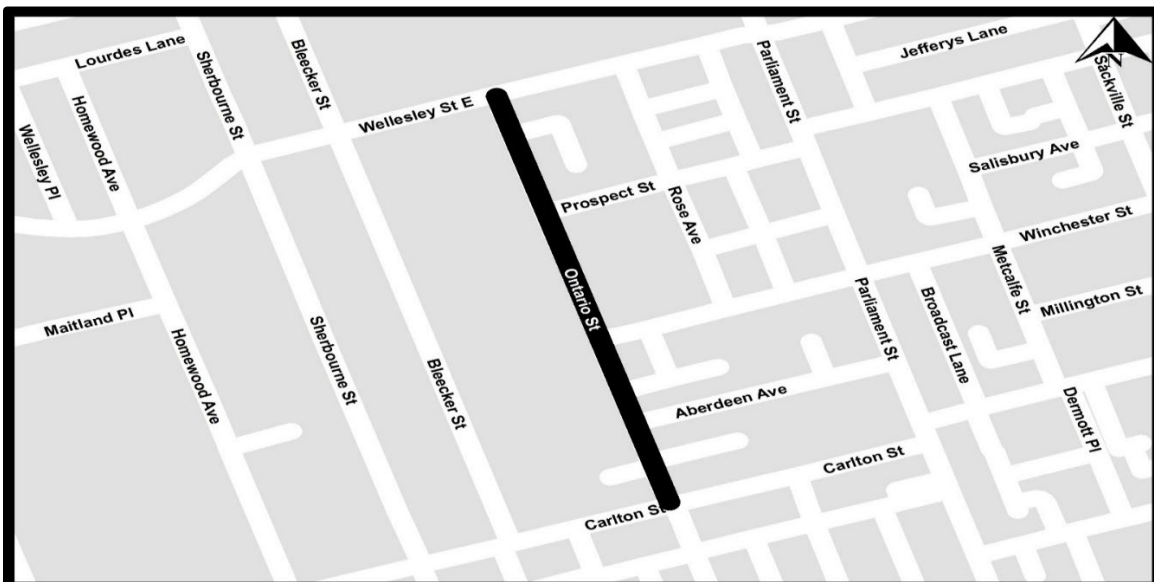
Extended construction hours are scheduled for **Sunday, August 2, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** to support overall project completion efforts.

Following completion of this weekend work period, crews will return to regular daytime working hours to complete the remaining construction.

Please be advised that the project schedule remains subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. The contractor will make every reasonable effort to minimize noise, maintain accessibility, and reduce disruptions to nearby residents, businesses, pedestrians, and road users.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Install porous asphalt paving on the sidewalk between Prospect Street and Garner Lane.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- The community will experience dust, noise, traffic delays, and other inconveniences.
- The City will make efforts to reduce the impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: To ensure the work is completed safely, road, sidewalk, and bikeway restrictions will be in effect within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated at no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Access for local traffic will be maintained.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need, or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
