Driveway Access



Dear Huntingwood Drive Residents,

As part of the road rehabilitation and bike lane improvements additional on street parking space installation work on Huntingwood Drive (**contract # 23ECS-RD-08MR**) the City’s contractor, Viola Management Inc, or their sub-contractor will be working in front of your property and will block driveway access during upcoming works.

Based on the construction schedule below residents should expect driveway access may be blocked intermittently as work progresses on the listed sections along Huntingwood Drive. Work that requires driveways being blocked will start on August 28,2026 and is expected to be completed as per the construction schedule.

Roads closed between	Direction	Date
Birchmount Road to Harfleur Road	Westbound	August 24 to August 30
Birchmount Road to Harfleur Road	Eastbound	August 31 to September 6
Garrybrook Drive to Davisbrook Boulevard	Westbound	September 7 to September 13
Garrybrook Drive to Davisbrook Boulevard	Eastbound	September 14 to September 20

Refer to the road sections identified in the schedule above to know when access to your driveway **may NOT be available. Our contractor will circulate notices and notify residents prior to work starting in the identified sections along Huntingwood Drive. Dates and times of the driveway closures will be based on daily progress of works weather permitting.**

During construction, residents may park their vehicles on nearby side streets while access to their driveways is temporarily blocked by construction activities.

Please leave a copy of this notice face up on your dashboard so that it is visible to Parking Enforcement Officers and ensure you park in a legal parking spot at all times.

If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (parking ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws.

If you receive a yellow parking violation notice during this construction work, please do one of the following within 15 days of the notice date to avoid additional fines or records being kept of non-payment:

1. Pay the parking violation fine (follow instructions on the back of the notice) or
2. File a Parking Violation Dispute with the City online, by mail, or in person (follow instructions on the back of the notice). As part of the dispute process, you may include this notice and/or other documentation from the City related to parking impacts resulting from construction. If you need a copy of the Construction Notice, please contact 311 to request a copy.

Please note: Parking violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in front of a fire hydrant, on sidewalks or boulevards, in fire routes, accessible loading zones, No Parking or No Stopping zones, or in violation of rush hour restrictions.
