Start Date: Summer 2025

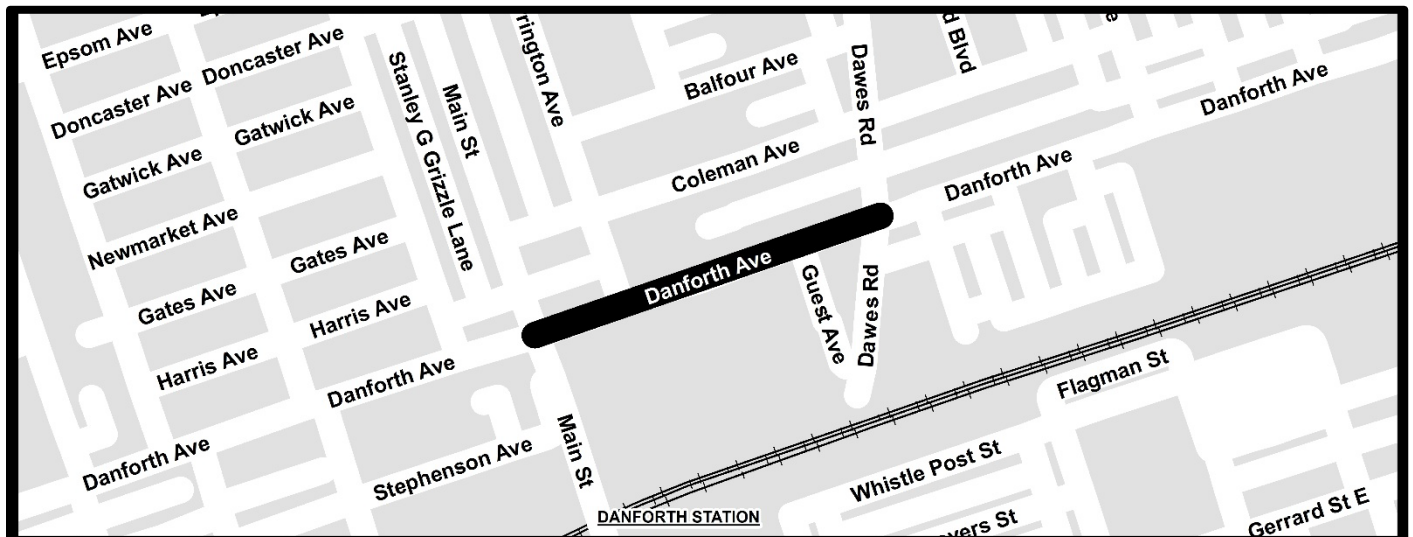
End Date: Fall 2026

This is to notify you that starting on **Wednesday, August 12**, Danforth Avenue will be closed eastbound (toward Scarborough) between Main Street and Dawes Road to facilitate bike lane installation. This closure is expected to be in place for a several weeks. Westbound traffic (toward downtown) will still be maintained. Please note that this timeline is weather dependant. Emergency vehicle access will always be maintained.

WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Install the bike lane on the south side of Danforth Avenue.

	Road and Sidewalk Access: To ensure the work is completed safely, road, sidewalk, and bikeway restrictions will be in effect within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Driveway Access: The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated at no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Motorists and pedestrians are asked to follow the posted detour route and obey all directions from Traffic Management Personnel who may be present on site.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need, or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
